Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners held a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday morning to discuss the Supplemental and Final Order Adopting Revised Political Boundaries following redistricting of Commissioner Court Precincts, the release of a maintenance bond for Lampasas River Place section 2, removing the Purchase Order Policy, requesting bids for asphalt and emulsion, the Lawn Maintenance Contract, the transfer, sale, or disposal of surplus property, and the TxDOT Public Hearing on US281-Lampasas to Evant Expansion. A proposal to adopt the Supplemental and Final Order for Revised Political Boundaries following redistricting of Commissioner Court Precincts was passed unanimously. Additionally a proposal to release a maintenance bond for Lampasas River Place section 2 was passed unanimously. The Purchase Order Policy and its importance were discussed briefly. The current policy states a purchase order is necessary when purchasing anything over

\$2500. Commissioner Mark Rainwater expressed concern with the policy. "It's useless. Getting rid of it will streamline things." A proposal to remove the purchase order policy was tabled for further discussion. A request for bids on asphalt and emulsion was approved and will take place on February 22nd—27th. The current Lawn & Maintenance contract expires in February 2023. A revised contract was approved unanimously. Yearly cost will be \$34,450, a 6% increase. The transfer, sale, and disposal of surplus property were discussed briefly. A sale for the surplus items will be available on Govdeals.com from March 13th—24th. TxDOT will hold a public hearing on February 7th, 2023 from 5:30-7:30 at the New Covenant Church in Lampasas to discuss the US281-Lampasas to Evant Expansion.

Lampasas City Council

The Lampasas City Council held a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday evening. The Workshop Session began with a public hearing with TxDOT regarding the Relief Route Feasibility Study. Several citizens expressed concern with the relief route citing a petition with over 1,200 signatures in opposition of the bypass. "The bypass will negatively change our town forever," a citizen said. The loss of land in regards to the relief route were discussed briefly. "My neighbor just put his house on the market today," citizen Warren Blunser said. "It's on US183, one of the proposed routes." Darrel Hearst, whose property will be affected by one of the proposed routes, spoke in opposition of the relief route. "Fredricksburg has a population of 11,000 and several highways running through it," Hearst said. "They don't have a bypass, so why do we need a bypass?" The regular session began with the consideration of proposed amendments to the Lampasas Zoning Ordinances Chapter III Zoning District Height & Area Regulations. Also included was the City Manager's operational report to include information on the Skate Park and Hostess House. Additionally, approval of the Contract for Election Services between Lampasas County and the City of Lampasas for the May 6th election and a proposed 35 mph speed zone for Lampasas High school on Highway 281. Proposed amendments to the Lampasas Zoning Ordinances Chapter III Zoning District Height & Area Regulations were passed unanimously. Construction on the Skate Park began on January 18th. Anticipated completion is 5 weeks. The Pre-Bid meeting for Hostess House renovations and upgrades was conducted on January 17th with approximately 26 subcontractors and general contractors attending. Bids are due February 14th and will be packaged for Council consideration at the February 27th meeting. The Contract for Election Services between Lampasas County and the (cont'd on back)

Council returned to regular session to discuss items on the executive session. The items included in the executive session were approved unanimously.
