Accident on Ave J/580E

Lampasas Radio received the following: "On 06.18.21 at 8:14 AM, the Lampasas Police Department received a 911 phone call reporting a motor vehicle accident in the 500 block of FM 580 East at the intersection of Old Convent Road. The initial investigation indicated a pickup truck, driven by the lone occupant, a 57 year old male who resides in Lampasas County, had been traveling north bound on Campbell Street. The driver had stopped at the stop sign at FM 580, then proceeded to cross the intersection to travel north on Old Convent Road. A motorcycle driven, by a 19 year old male who also resides in Lampasas County, was traveling west on FM 580 and struck the pickup truck on its passenger side door. The pickup truck's driver was uninjured. The motorcycle's driver was significantly injured, treated and transported by Acadian Ambulance to the Lampasas Airport where Air Vac air ambulance transported him to the Scott and White Hospital in Temple. The pickup truck's driver was cited at the scene for Fail to Yield Vehicle in Intersection. As of the time of this release, the driver was still being treated at Scott and White Hospital. The investigation is on-going. The Lampasas Police were assisted on scene by the Lampasas Fire Department, Texas Department of Public Safety Highway Patrol, Texas Department of Transportation, the Lampasas County Precinct One Constable, and the City of Lampasas Streets Dept.

The Sheriff's Dept. Blotter shows Lometa with an alarm call. Kempner shows a medical call, animal issues, a request for extra patrol, a reported disturbance and a reported fraud. Out in the county there was a reported runaway, medical calls, livestock/animal issues, delivery of a message, and a reported theft.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 30 year old Johnny Keeter of Brady for failure to appear and an out-of-county charge. 34 year old Jamichael Moore Sr. was arrested on a probation violation and a commitment charge.

Study: Texas bases lead Army posts in risk of sexual assault

According to a new Rand Corp. study, female soldiers at Army bases in Texas, Colorado, Kansas and Kentucky face a greater risk of sexual assault and harassment than those at other posts, accounting for more than a third of all active-duty Army women sexually assaulted in 2018.

The study, released Friday, looked at Army incidents, and found that female soldiers at Fort Hood and Fort Bliss, both in Texas, faced the highest risk, particularly those in combat commands or jobs such as field artillery and engineering. And units with more frequent deployments to war also saw higher risk.

The Rand report also confirmed one of the Army's conclusions about the impact of command climate, finding a lower risk of sexual misconduct in units with more positive supervisor scores.

The Fort Hood violence prompted an independent review which found that military leaders were not adequately dealing with high

rates of sexual assault and harassment at the post. Christopher Swecker, the chairman of the review panel, told Congress that the base leaders were focused on military readiness and completely neglected the sexual assault prevention program. As a result, he said, lower-level unit commanders didn't encourage service members to report assaults, and in many cases were shaming victims.

In the wake of the Vanessa Guillen killing and a spike in suicides last year, Army leaders launched a program in October that focuses on the wellbeing of soldiers and their families, specifically making people the Army's top priority, overtaking combat readiness and weapons modernization.

The broader effort also is aimed at improving the command climate in units, since poor leadership was identified as a significant problem at Fort Hood.
