Legislative Special Session Scheduled

After Texas Governor Greg Abbott vetoed the part of the State Budget that covered the Legislature expenses, its staffers and legislative agencies, he has announced a special session to begin on July $8^{\rm th}$.

According to the Texas Tribune, when they're back in Austin next month, lawmakers can pass a supplemental budget to restore that funding — though the item would first need to be included on the governor's special session agenda. The document would also need a signature from Abbott before it could go into effect.

The Texas Tribune goes on to report that Abbott's office did not specify what legislative priorities will be included on the special session agenda and said in an advisory that such items "will be announced prior to the convening of the special session."

Abbott has already said that he plans to ask state lawmakers to work on two priority elections and bail bills that died in the final hours of the regular legislative session after House Democrats walked out of the chamber.

More recently, Abbott has said the agenda for the Legislature's overtime round will also include further restricting in schools the teaching of critical race theory, and the GOP elections bill Senate Bill 7.

Republicans, including Dan Patrick, the lieutenant governor, have asked Abbott to include legislation that would ban the practice known as taxpayer-funded lobbying and a bill that would restrict the participation of transgender student athletes in school sports — two items that failed to pass during the regular session.
