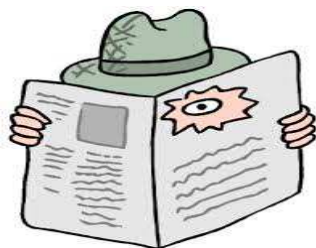

Would you like to learn how to deal with the special challenges of gardening and landscaping in Central Texas? Texas A&M Agrilife Extension Service is offering a Master Gardener Certification course through the Highland Lakes Master Gardener Association. "Good morning Badger Nation. Soccer season is officially upon us and I am very excited with the group that we have put together this year. We started off this past weekend in a scrimmage tournament against Killeen and Shoemaker. Our JV was able to tie Killeen 0-0 and sadly feel 0-4 to Shoemaker, but put up a great fight with a lot of lessons learned. Our varsity fell to Killeen 0-3 but held them to a 0-0 tie at halftime. It was a very good back and forth game, but an impactful injury to a key player was enough to disrupt our flow and allow Killeen to find the back of the net three times in the second half. Our efforts against Shoemaker were again dashed with a 1-2 loss. We were able to go up 1-0 in the first half with a great run by freshman Willow Gill into the opponents box to draw a PK. Junior Sara Engelke put this one into the back of the net to take us up at half. We had a couple of lax moments where Shoemaker was able to capitalize and eek one out in the last seconds of the game to go up 2-1 for a final. On this past Monday, we took on 6A rival Copperas Cove. Our JV team gained some great experience and was able to overcome a two point deficit to tie it up at the end of regulation 2-2. Raelean Sutton scored our first goal with Lexi Velasquez putting the second in from a corner kick sent on from Brooke Coffman.

Our varsity match was a true David vs Goliath match with cove having an expert squad of 8 seniors vs our young squad with 5 freshman being called up. We were able to hold cove close throughout most of the first half with them in a 0-1 lead but right before the end of the half they were able to sneak two more in to go up 0-3 at halftime.
