High yesterday was 60° Low this morning was 48°



Winds are now coming out of the NW following a cold front earlier this morning. Sustained winds from the NW will be 5-10 mph with possible gusts to 25 mph possible. The skies are clear, and with the clear skies and the abating of the wind speed, low temperatures should dip into the 30's throughout the region, with some areas getting below freezing. The forecasters are saying another trough will dip down on Monday giving the front a nudge to the south and reinforcing the cool airmass in place. The lows on Monday night should be in the 30's, and on Tuesday night to Wednesday morning we may see freezing temperatures.

**Today:** Mostly cloudy then becoming mostly sunny with a high near 57°. Wind will be NW at 5-10 mph gusting to 25 mph.

**Tonight:** Clear with a low near 36°. Winds will be W-NW at 5-10 mph.

**Saturday:** Sunny with a high near 68°. W wind at 5-10 mph.

**Saturday night:** S wind at 5-10 mph. Clear skies and a low near 41°.

**Sunday:** Sunny with a high temperature near 72°. Winds will be SW at 10-15 mph shifting W-NW in the afternoon.

**Overnight:** Clear and a low near 39°. Winds will be NW at 5 mph shifting SW in the evening.

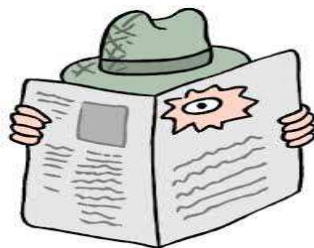
