The Weather



High yesterday was 61° Low this morning was 45°

Today look for the winds to shift to the north this afternoon, then swing around to the south. Tonight this light breeze will keep lows in the upper 30's and low 40's.

Today: Sunny with winds from the W at 5-10 mph and a high near 69°.

Tonight: Clear with winds shifting to the SW at 5-10 mph after midnight. The low will drop to the low 40s.

Sunday: Sunny with a high temperature near 73°. SW wind 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Sunday Night: Clear skies with a low near 40° and W-SW wind at 5-10 mph.

Monday: Wind will be SW at 5-15 mph with sunny skies and a high near 72°.

Monday Night: A low near 38° and mostly clear skies with N winds at 10-15 mph.

New Businesses Opening in Lampasas

Lampasas Radio has learned that the new owner of the "Wildflowers on the Wall" building took possession on the 1st of the month.



The business, according to Mandy Walsh of the Lampasas Economic Development Corporation, will be a family-oriented Craft Beer and Italian Food establishment.

The owner already has two other businesses, the Leander Beer Market and the Liberty Hill Beer Market. This will be the Lampasas Beer Market. The owner has family in Lampasas.

The business will feature 48 taps specializing in craft beer, rotating every two weeks. Also planned is what we term "Italian Comfort Food" such as calzones, lasagna and, hopefully good spaghetti.

The Lampasas Beer Market should be open hopefully by the end of

March, but with restoring and construction on these historic buildings that can vary.

Ms. Walsh also shared that the "Cherry on Top" DIY craft and Ice Cream store will be opening in the Old World Bakery building on Western. There is no time-line for that opening as of today.

We are also saddened to hear of the closing of the 281 Café and Dance Hall in the AmVets building. The last day of business will be tomorrow, Sunday January 5th.

And last but not least, with the end-of-construction confusion, Burger King was unable to get their final "Certificate of Occupancy". We understand that is now taken care of, and they hope to be open by the end of January. New Employees are training in Burnet.

State Sales Tax Revenue Shows December Increase

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar today said state sales tax revenue totaled \$3.01 billion in December, 4.8 percent more than in December 2018/

"Growth in state sales tax revenue was led by receipts from the construction, information services and restaurant sectors," Hegar said. "While revenue growth was slightly buoyed by collections from remote sellers and online marketplace providers, collections from retail trade were depressed due to significantly fewer Christmas shopping days in November this year compared to the previous year."

The majority of December sales tax revenue is based on sales made in November and remitted to the agency in December. Total sales tax revenue for the three months ending in December 2019 was up 6.0 percent compared to the same period a year ago. Sales tax is the largest source of state funding for the state budget, accounting for 57 percent of all tax collections.

In December 2019, Texas collected the following revenue from other major taxes:

- motor vehicle sales and rental taxes — \$427.3 million, up 7.9 percent from December 2018;
- motor fuel taxes — \$310.7 million, down 1.1 percent from December 2018;
- natural gas production taxes — \$114.0 million, down 33.8 percent from December 2018; and oil production taxes — \$362.5 million, up 18.3 percent from December 2018.
