The Weather



The High yesterday 68° The Low this morning 40°

Today should be pleasant with mostly clear skies and a high in the 60's with light breezes from the north. The weather-maker this week shows up on Wednesday morning with a cold front making its way through the region with possible scattered showers as it moves across the area. Cooler air is expected to move in behind the front, with high temperatures on Thursday in the upper 40's to low 50's. Another round of cold air is slated to move through on Friday, with a cold rain likely.

Today: Look for sunny skies and a high temperature near 67°. Winds will be W at 5-10mph shifting N-NE this afternoon.

Tonight: Clear with the low temperature near 36°, and winds becoming calm.

Tuesday: Sunny with a high near 65°, with winds becoming S-SE at 5-10mph in the afternoon.

Tuesday Night: Increasing clouds with a low near 48°. Winds will be S at 5-10mph.

Wednesday: Mostly sunny skies and a 20% chance of precipitation in the morning with a high near 61°. SW winds at 5-10mph will become N-NW at 15-20 in the afternoon with 25mph gusts possible.

Wednesday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 36°, and W-NW winds at 5-10 mph, gusting to 20mph.

Coronavirus Update

Lampasas Radio heard from Dr. this morning that Lampasas County has 68 active cases and 993 total cases. There are 4 Lampasans in the hospital.



The State of Texas reported 14,535 new cases on Sunday with 12,563 Texans hospitalized with Coronavirus.

Trauma Service Area "L" this morning showed 139 available hospital beds, and 13 ICU beds, with 78 ventilator beds available. There were 209 Covid Patients in the hospital in our trauma service area as of today.

And Finding the Covid-19 Vaccine

In the midst of the confusion about the Coronavirus Vaccine distribution, the Radiogram learned that CVS pharmacy visited Lampasas Nursing & Rehab Saturday and administered the first phase of the Pfizer to 25 staff members and 30 residents. (The rest declined.) Cedar Hill living center will be receiving vaccines from Walgreens staff on Wednesday, and approximately 100 doses are expected for staff & patients. Lily Springs Nursing Home told Lampasas Radio that they vaccinated residents & staff about 2 weeks ago.

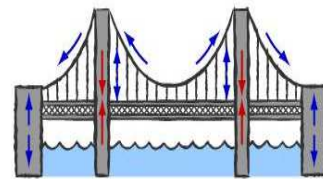
A phone call to Fire Chief Jeff Smith of the Lampasas Fire Dept. revealed that Chief Smith checked with providers and are not eligible to receive the vaccine at this time due to being categorized EMT's, not Paramedics. EMT's are apparently in a different tier as Paramedics.

Chief Sammy Bailey tells us that no police officers have received the vaccination as of this time.

The DSHS website shows that nearby AdventHealth on Clear Creek in Killeen was shipped 1400 doses of the Moderna vaccine.

Bridge Inspections

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will inspect two San Saba County bridges that cross the Colorado River on January 13-15. The inspections will be performed TxDOT's contractor, WSP USA.

The Colorado River Bridge on SH 16, located about 12 miles north of San Saba, will be inspected on Wed., Jan. 13. The inspection of the Colorado River Bridge on US 190, located about 10 miles southeast of San Saba, will take place on Thurs., Jan 14 and Fri., Jan. 15. During inspections at both locations, motorists should expect possible delays with alternating lane closures. A pilot car will assist traffic through the work zone. Please use caution, slow your speed and watch for crews.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requires bridges to be inspected every two years. These two bridges are due for regular inspection at this time.
