## More on the Omicron Variant In Texas

(Texas Tribune) The number of Texans hospitalized each day with COVID-19 continued to rise over the New Year's holiday, according to state health numbers released Monday, as the omicron variant continues to drive new cases and hospitals await desperately needed staffing help to respond to new admissions.

As of Monday, more than 7,000 Texans were hospitalized with COVID-19, more than double the number two weeks ago but still far below the pandemic peak of 14,218 on Jan. 11, 2021.

Health experts — and history — warn that the peak of the current surge in Texas is likely still ahead, as the highly contagious omicron variant of the virus rages through the state after Texans return from a season of gatherings and travel.

Millions of people are now vaccinated or have natural immunity, and there are more treatments available to keep people out of hospitals. The omicron variant is also thought to cause less severe illness in some cases, although the data on that is far from



conclusive.

But the omicron variant, which doctors say appears to be as contagious as the measles, could wind up sending more people to the hospital than during previous surges — even if it is a milder version of the virus — simply due to the sheer volume of people it's infecting, Dr. Jason Bowling, epidemiologist at University Health in San Antonio.

Omicron has become the dominant variant in the state less than a month after it was first detected. The delta variant took several months to become dominant in Texas. That means the state's medical community could be in for a bumpy ride this month as the virus infects people at an unprecedented rate.

"We're all just buckling in again," Bowling said.

In Texas, the share of tests coming back positive in recent days has broken all previous pandemic records, according to state data.

On Monday, the state was given approval from the federal government for the opening of six federal testing sites across the state after a request Friday from Gov. Greg Abbott and state emergency management officials, said Lara Anton, spokesperson for the Texas Department of State Health Services.

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, (some of these are a backlog from last week) there were 51,481 new and 9,394 probable new cases on January 3rd, along with 78 deaths. There were also 7,015 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard shows 67 cases confirmed yesterday, and 100 cases for the last week. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 116 active cases at this time.

## Powerball Expected to Reach 575 million

The Powerball jackpot will increase to become, at least, the ninth largest jackpot in the game's history Wednesday after nobody picked all the winning numbers Monday night. But there are still three new millionaires.

The jackpot was \$561.3 million Monday night, an increase of more than \$40 million since Saturday. The winning numbers were 2, 13, 32, 33 and 48. The Powerball was 22 and the PowerPlay multiplier was 2x.

Powerball said there was a \$2 million winner in Montana and \$1 million winners in Connecticut and Texas.

The jackpot now goes up to an estimated \$575 million Wednesday. It would be the 9th-largest all time if it stays there, but jackpots often increase dramatically due to increased ticket sales when they get this large. The lump sum payout for a jackpot winner would be \$409.3 million.

Since Aug. 23, Powerball drawings have been held three times a week to increase interest and grow prizes more quickly. Drawings are held each Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:59 p.m. Eastern.

The last time someone hit jackpot was Oct. 4 in California, winning \$699.8 million. That jackpot was the seventh largest in U.S. lottery

history and fifth largest in Powerball history.

The chance of winning all that money is minuscule at one in 292.2 million. The odds of winning in general are 1 in 24.9. It's not uncommon to have months go by without a grand prize winner.
