Family of tow truck driver killed in hit-and-run asking Texans to be cautious: 'slow down, move over'

According to a story from KWTX, it's been nearly one month since Patrick Morin was killed in a hit and run accident in Mills County.

"How much time is it going to add to your trip if you just slow down and move over?" Asked Patrick's wife, Mitzi Morin.

According to the Texas Department of Public Safety, Morin was loading a vehicle onto his tow truck along US183 near Goldthwaite when a Toyota Tundra, driven by 38-year-old Kerry Kavanaugh, struck him then failed to stop and render aid.

"By not putting on a seatbelt you're playing with your own life. When you go by somebody on the side of the road you're playing with somebody else's life at that point," said Patrick's son Kristopher Morin. "It just really upsets me that there's not respect or they're not following the law. I do see it as a lack of respect for life," said Mitzi Morin.

Since the accident, groups like the highway angels have given the Morin family an unwavering amount of support. Now, the family is working to protect the safety of other tow truck drivers as a part of Patrick's legacy. "It's important to honor Patrick by trying to save someone else's life," said Mitzi.

According to TxDOT, The Move Over or Slow Down law, which traditionally has required drivers to yield to police, fire and emergency vehicles, has been expanded over the years to provide the same protection for TxDOT work crews and other roadside workers.

This law requires drivers to move over a lane or slow to 20 mph below the posted speed limit when approaching emergency vehicles, law enforcement, tow trucks, utility service vehicles, TxDOT vehicles or other highway construction or maintenance vehicles using visual signals or flashing lights activated on the roadside. On roadways with posted speed limits of 25 miles per hour or less, drivers must reduce their speed to 5 miles per hour (Texas Transportation Code 545.157)

Drivers who fail to give emergency and work crews space to safely do their jobs can receive a ticket with a fine of up to \$200. If there is a crash that causes injury to a worker, drivers can be fined up to \$2,000.

Saturday January 14th brings the cattle show at 8am and at 3:30pm all exhibitors must report to the show barn kitchen to eat and then help serve for the Buyer's Appreciation Dinner at 5pm and the premium sale at 6:30pm.

Sunday January 15th all animals and projects must be out of the barn by 8am and clean up of the show barn begins at 9am
