## The Weather

**Note:** Thermal profiles support a brief period of a rain/snow mix early Sunday morning across portions of the Big Country and Central Texas

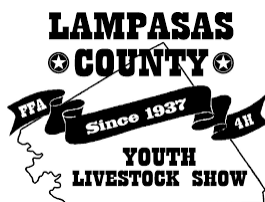
## County Youth Stock Show Begins

The Lampasas County Youth Livestock Association is beginning their annual stock show today. This afternoon Ag Mechanics moves in, and must be completed by 7pm.

Beginning tomorrow, animals may begin arriving to the barn at 8am. 7am begins the rabbit check-in with the show to immediately follow in the Show Ring.

Noon to 1pm brings the food fair check-in, at the conclusion of the rabbit show but not before noon. Food fair judging starts at 1pm. Swine check-in begins at 4pm and goes until 6pm. 5pm is the food fair awards in the show ring, and also at 5pm market lambs begin to weigh and classify followed by market goats. Breeding goat weigh-in will follow market goats. 6pm sees the Swine check-in closing and an exhibitor meeting in the show ring. 7pm the broiler check-in starts with show to follow in the Show Ring. By 7pm tomorrow, all animals with the exception of cattle must be in place/tack for cattle exhibitors must be in place.

Lampasas Radio will be broadcasting the show on 101.9fm, be sure to tune in .



## County Roll-Backs Required Due to Covid-19

County Judge Randy Hoyer received word yesterday from DSHS commissioner John Hellerstedt that the Trauma Service Area "L", of which Lampasas County is included in has exceeded 15% of total hospital capacity with covid-19 patients. Reaching this threshold requires that businesses in our county return to 50% occupancy, and no elective surgeries in Lampasas County. This order will continue until Trauma Service Area L has seven consecutive days in which the number of Covid-19 hospitalized patients as a percentage of total hospital capacity is 15% or less. Judge Hoyer advises that "Until the Covid-19 vaccine is readily available to all residents of Lampasas County, I encourage you to continue wearing a face covering in public, wash your hands and maintain social distancing."

## Visit with the City Manager

Lampasas City Manager Finley de Graffenried was in Lampasas Radio studios this morning for his weekly visit with Ronnie Witcher.

They spoke about the Covid-19 vaccine roll out, and that it has not been done efficiently (see story below). They also touched on the fact that Lampasas County has to roll back some occupancy limits due to high hospitalizations. Mr. de Graffenried pointed out that everyone wants precise answers, and the coronavirus and our response changes as needed. Please be patient.

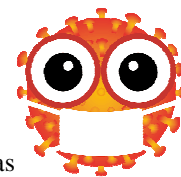
When asked about permanent changes due to Covid, Mr. de Graffenried feels we will see more home built with home offices, and homes being fiber-ready.

With the coronavirus, the city had some financial impacts in 2020, our sales tax rebates are up \$200,000 for the year, and building permit revenue is up 25%. It was also pointed out by the city manager that the city did not have the cost of the Hanna Springs Pool this summer, as well as other events that were a financial savings for the city. People also seem to be frequenting local businesses as opposed to traveling to nearby cities.

## Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay shared this morning that Lampasas County now has 1057 total cases, an increase of 24 cases reported since yesterday. The number of active cases in our county is 98, up 13 from yesterday, and 7 residents of Lampasas County are in the hospital.

The State of Texas saw a whopping 26,543 new confirmed cases yesterday, (may be a data issue/catch-up) and 13,308 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

## On the Covid-19 Vaccine...

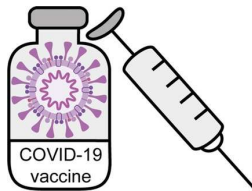
Things still seem a little murky about the general population receiving the covid-19 vaccine.

After some research this morning, (and very few people seem to know anything for sure), it appears that when the allocation of vaccines is calculated, the number sent to that facility is still for the first phase of recipients. So the 100 doses sent to the DSHS in Lampasas are already allocated for a particular location or group of people.

Dr. Hay shared that she is working on obtaining the vaccines for our EMS, Fire and Police front line workers. She stated the vaccine has not been released for her to begin the process.

The DSHS website shows that Lampasas County has had 146 people vaccinated with one dose, and no one has been vaccinated with the second dose.

Also, according to the DSHS website, as of 1:50pm yesterday, Texas has been sent 1,333,450 total doses of the vaccine. Of the vaccines received, only 439,502 doses have been administered. That is a total of 32.95% of the available vaccine. Why they are not being administered appears to be the question, and no one seems to have answers.
