As of Monday morning's release of the Texas

Association of Basketball Coaches UIL Rankings, neither of the Badger basketball teams, Girls or Boys, made it into their top 25 in Texas 4A.

In the Girls rankings, none of the District 6 teams, consisting of Lampasas, Salado, Taylor, Burnet, Liberty Hill and Eastside Memorial made it into the top 25.
