Pullet show followed by cockerel show


7:00 p.m. – All animals, except cattle must be in place. Tack for all cattle exhibitors must be in place.

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced today he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts \$783.2 million in local sales tax allocations for January.

These allocations are based on sales made in November by businesses that report tax monthly.



In Lampasas County Lometa received a rebate check for \$7166.40, a 12.17% increase. Kempner received a rebate for \$9,834.75, a 3.54% decrease. The city of Lampasas saw a 19.26% increase in sales tax rebates, for a total of \$189,712.92.

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay shared this morning that Lampasas County now has 1067 total cases, an increase of 10 cases reported since yesterday. The number of active cases in our county is 102, up 4from yesterday, and 7 residents of Lampasas County are in the hospital.

The State of Texas saw a whopping 19,535 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 4,095 new probable cases. and 13,628 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

Vaccinations...

The DSHS website shows that as of yesterday at 3:30pm, Lampasas County has had 166 people vaccinated with one dose, and no one has been vaccinated with the second dose.

Also, according to the DSHS website, as of 3:30 pm yesterday, Texas has been sent 1,375,000 total doses of the vaccine. This indicates 41,550 doses were sent to Texas since Wednesday/. Of the vaccines received, only 482,045 doses have been administered. That is a total of 35.05% of the available vaccine.


