The Weather

The High yesterday 72° The Low this morning 32°

Look for temperatures to warm into the 60's again, and winds will become gusty by noontime. The humidity values will be dropping this afternoon to below 30%. The windy and dry conditions and above normal temperatures will create an elevated threat for grass fires. The conditions change overnight and tomorrow morning as the low level moisture comes quickly across Central Texas. The Southerly wind will keep lows on Thursday night near 60°. Look for a line of storms to develop along a cold front on Friday.

Today: Sunny with a high near 65°. S wind 5-10 mph increasing in the afternoon, gusting to 30 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low near 56° and S wind at 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph. Patchy drizzle is possible early Thursday morning.

Thursday: Mostly cloudy with a high near 72°. Wind will be S at 15-20 mph, and could gust as high as 30 mph.

Thursday Night: A low near 59° and mostly cloudy skies. Wind will be S at 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Friday: Partly sunny with a high temperature near 75°, and a 20% chance of showers and thunderstorms. Wind will be SW at 10-20 mph and could gust as high as 25 mph.

Friday Night: Partly cloudy with a low near 39° and SW wind near 10-15 mph becoming N-NW after midnight. Wind gusts could reach 20 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with a high near 55°. NW winds at 15-20 mph gusting to 25 mph. Winds will decrease in the afternoon.

The Lampasas County Youth Stock Show is gearing up fast, with the AG Mechanics projects moving into the show barn today. The projects have to be in place by 7pm.

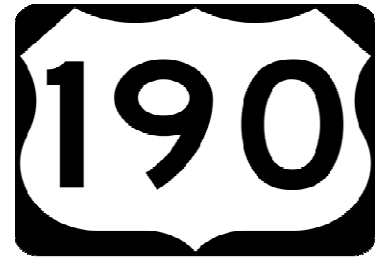

Another accident on US 190

Lampasas Radio received the following press release from DPS this

The driver of the Chevrolet pick-up, as well as the front seat passenger, were transported to Scott and White Hospital in Temple for injuries. The driver and two juvenile passengers in the Chevrolet SUV were not injured. Crash investigation is complete."

Flood Control Structure Seminar

"The Lampasas River Watershed Partnership is collaborating with the Lampasas County Water Control & Improvement District #1 (WCID) to host a seminar on the Sulphur Creek Flood Structure System on January 28 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in Lampasas. This seminar will offer local citizens a chance to learn about the 9 flood control structures upstream of the city of Lampasas and the services they provide.

The seminar is offered at no charge and will include light refreshments. The workshop will be held at the Old Lampasas Middle School Cafeteria, which is located on Western Avenue, between North Avenue and Avenue B. The address to the campus is 207 E. Ave. A, Lampasas.

The WCID is the local sponsor for operations and maintenance of nine flood control dams on the Sulphur Creek watershed, along with their local co-sponsor, the Hill Country Soil and Water Conservation District. In April 1957, these local sponsors executed a work plan with the USDA Soil Conservation Service (now Natural Resource Conservation Service) to build the dams upstream of the city of Lampasas. The following month, the last of eight historic floods occurred in Lampasas, resulting in several deaths. The subsequent construction of these dams rendered the May 1957 flood the last in Lampasas to date.

Sixty-three years later, the nine dams remain an important safeguard against future disaster. As flooding becomes a top priority in central Texas and across the state, it's important that citizens are aware of the services that these dams provide. As these dams age, they will require additional maintenance to continue to provide those same services.
