The Weather



The High yesterday 65° The Low this morning 59°

Forecasters say to look for gusty southerly winds at 15-20 mph today with gusts in the 25-30 mph category. Winds are not expected to reach wind advisory criteria. However, cross winds on north to south roads may cause issues with high profile vehicles. Partial sunshine may appear west of the 281 corridor. Tonight should be breezy and mild with lows in the mid 50's in our area.

The wind advisory will be reviewed later today, but Central Texas has the possibility of gusts in excess of 30 mph overnight. The risk of severe weather has shifted westward to include much of Central Texas.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 73°. S wind at 15-20 mph gusting as high as 30 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low around 61° and S wind at 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Friday: Mostly cloudy, with a high near 72° with a 70% chance of storms after noon. Winds will be S at 15-20 mph with possible gusts as high as 25 mph.

Friday Night: Winds will be W-NW at 10-15 shifting NW at 15-20 mph early Saturday morning. Winds could gust as high as 30 mph. Skies will be mostly cloudy with a low of 37°.

Saturday: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 53° and N-NW wind at 15-20 mph with gusts as high as 30 mph, decreasing in the afternoon.

Saturday Night: 34° with mostly clear skies. N wind at 5-10 mph shifting to the S after midnight.
