The Weather



The High Yesterday: 59° The Low this Morning: 33°

The National Weather Service updated this statement at 1:55am Saturday: ": A strong winter storm system will track across Texas late tonight into Sunday. Widespread precipitation will form within this storm system, transitioning from rain to snow across much of the region on Sunday. While there still remains uncertainty on the exact snowfall amounts that can be expected, and where the heaviest snow amounts will occur, accumulating snowfall appears

likely for portions of North and Central Texas beginning late tonight and continuing through the day Sunday"

Saturday: Mostly sunny then becoming mostly cloudy in the afternoon with an advancing weather system. Winds will be light from the east and the high will be near 51° .

Saturday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low near 35°. Winds will be E at 5-10 mph gusting to 20mph. There are precipitation chances across Central Texas after midnight, with snow possible. The NWS tells us that areas along and west of 281 may see 2-4" of snow.

Sunday: Cloudy skies with a 100% chance of precipitation, the possibility of rain changing to snow and a high near 36°. Winds will be NE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Overnight Sunday: Mostly cloudy and cold with a 20% chance of rain or snow and a low near 29°. Winds will be N-NW near 10 mph with possible gusts of 20mph.

Monday: Partly sunny skies with a high temperature near 43°. Winds will be N-NW near 10 mph.

Monday Night: Mostly clear, with a low around 24°.

The Blotter

Coronavirus Update



Dr. Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that Lampasas County has a total of 1090 cases, up by 17 since yesterday, 96 active cases (an increase of 4

from Friday), and 8 in the hospital with one on a ventilator. The State of Texas recorded 17,335 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 5,611 probable cases. 13,921 Texans are hospitalized with Coronavirus

Vaccinations...

The DSHS website shows that as of yesterday at 2pm, Lampasas County has had 197 people vaccinated with one dose, an increase of 22 vaccinations since Thursday and no one has been vaccinated with the second dose.

Also, according to the DSHS website, as of 3:40 pm yesterday, Texas has been sent 1,488,5500 total doses of the vaccine. This number represents an increase of 125,700 doses shown in the DSHS website. Of the vaccines received, 589,332 doses have been administered, up from 541,512 yesterday. A total of 41.2% of doses recorded in Texas have been administered.







Monday Meetings

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court will hold a regular meeting Monday at 9am in the Commissioners' Courtroom at the Lampasas Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda, the treasurer's quarterly report and monthly reports from some of the County Offices; Accounts payable/payroll; the turn-key health contract for the Lampasas County Sheriff's Office; Chapter 59 Audit announcements; approving a Kempner waterline on CR3600 right-of-way; a pay increase for a designated representative for Lampasas County; and, of course, the Jail Project

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday evening for a workshop, executive, special and regular session at 5:30pm. The agenda for the workshop session includes updates on the pandemic and CARES act funding, a new date for the council planning session, follow-up relating to the 281S traffic signals/ signage, and an Interlocal agreement. The council will then go into executive session for an economic development issue, then return to a special session for discussion and possible action discussed in executive session. Council will then begin the regular meeting which includes a public hearing on a request to rezone property at 907E. 3rd St. from light industrial to 2 family residential. The agenda also includes discussion and possible action on adopting the budget, an SUP for a vapor store, an SUP to allow for a portable storage building, board & departmental reports, routine matters to include the city manager's operational report, and mayor's comments. New business includes amending the Interlocal agreement for the ETJ in Lampasas county, amending sick leave for city employees, discussion of a joint election agreement between Lampasas ISD and the city of Lampasas.

The Lampasas ISD School Board has a regular meeting scheduled for Monday in the Lampasas ISD administration building. The agenda includes the consent agenda, a public hearing for Texas Academic Performance Report, Administrative Reports to include Enrollment, curriculum, a campus report from Lampasas Middle School, and support services. Also included are the superintendent's evaluation and consideration of Employee Benefits.
