The Weather



High yesterday was 71° Low this morning was 65°

The forecasters are saying that a "significant damaging wind event associated with a squall line is possible", however the worst weather at this time is expected to be closer to and east of I35. The storms are expected to be fast moving and may develop with little or no warning. They may include tornadoes. Dew points in the 60's should allow storms to erupt in a line from Gainesville to Weatherford to Comanche in the 2pm-3pm timeframe. The storms should be out of here tonight. After cool mornings on Saturday and Sunday the dry airmass will allow temperatures to rebound into the 60's.

Today: A high near 72° . Wind will be S at 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph. 90% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon, with some of the storms possibly severe.

Tonight: A 30% chance of showers and storms with the threat of severe weather continuing until about 9pm. Otherwise mostly cloudy with a low near 36°. Winds will be W at 10-15 mph shifting to the NW and becoming a little stronger overnight. Wind gusts could get as high as 25 mph.

Saturday: A mostly cloudy morning with gradual clearing and a high near 52°. NW wind at15-20 mph, gusting to 30 mph, decreasing in the afternoon.

Saturday night: N-NW wind at 5-10 mph shifting S-SE in the night. Clear skies and a low near 36° .

Sunday: Sunny with a high temperature near 63°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph, gusting to 20 mph.

Overnight: Partly cloudy and a low near 40°. Winds will be S at 5 mph.




