Commissioner's Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court will meet this morning for a regularly scheduled meeting. The Agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, a replat of Hilltop Acres, awarding the bid for abatement and demolition of the old jail/sheriff's office, approval of the 2022 Joint Primary Resolution, amending the outdoor burning guidelines/burn ban, an order vacating redistricting orders, a resolution electing to become eligible to participate in tax abatement and an order adopting tax abatement guidelines.

City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet this evening for regularly scheduled meetings. The Workshop session at 5:30pm will include discussion and updates related to the Covid 19 pandemic, the February Council Work Session, an emergency ordinance for Covid-19 sick leave policy and discussion regarding the TxDOT request to purchase City of Lampasas Property on 281S for proposed improvements.

The Regular Session which begins at 6pm will include the consent agenda, Board and Departmental reports, the City Manager's Operational Report to include a residential update, LAFTA events, an update about the skatepark, and the library dedication. In new business, Council will include discussion and possible action concerning a specific use permit for 2209 S. Hwy 183 in Lampasas, a joint election agreement between Lampasas ISD and the City of Lampasas, funding to the CTCOG household hazardous waste collection event in February 26, 2022, discussion of purchasing a fire apparatus, and the purchase by Tx DOT of land on 281S for road improvements.

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, on January 9th , there were 34,814 new and 7,977 probable cases, along with 9,872 in the hospital. There were 48 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, in the last 14 days, Lampasas has seen 218 confirmed cases according to the DSHS website, with 78 being confirmed on Saturday and 6 being confirmed Sunday. The state estimate is now 252 active cases in Lampasas County.
