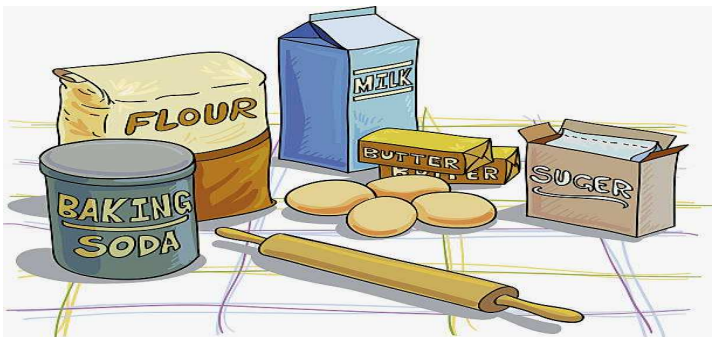

The Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees will have a school board meeting at 6pm today. The Agenda includes second readings and approval of policy updates, appointments to the Lampasas High School Alumni Scholarship Fund Committee, Election Agreements, The Public Hearing for the Texas Academic Performance Report, Administrative records, and possible consultation with attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

The Lampasas City Council will meet this afternoon at 5:30 for a workshop session, which will include discussion regarding amending the landscaping ordinance/or creating a tree preservation ordinance for the City of Lampasas, and discussion regarding the 2020 Council Work Plan. The regular session will then start at 7pm.

The agenda for the regular meeting includes the usual consent agenda, discussion and possible action regarding the approval of the second reading of an Ordinance amending the adopted budget for the Municipal Government of the City of Lampasas for the prior fiscal year. Also included on the agenda are monthly reports and routine matters. In new business the agenda includes discussion and possible action regarding amendment of the regular city council meeting time, amendments to the City of Lampasas fee schedule specifically pertaining to building permit fees, curb cut fees and tap fees. No mention of the new "Tree Ordinance".
