The Weather



The High yesterday 44° The Low this morning 42°

Today: Cloudy, with a high near 53° this afternoon and light south wind increasing to 5-10 mph in the afternoon.

Tonight: Patchy drizzle and fog after midnight. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 43° and south wind 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Patchy drizzle and fog before 11am. Cloudy, then gradually mostly sunny with a high of 67° and S-SW wind 5-15 mph with gusts to 20. Overnight a low of 50° with clouds and a light south wind.

Rest of the week: Sunshine and a nice 71° on Thursday afternoon with the wind turning to westerly at 5-10 mph. Overnight it will become partly cloudy with a low around 49° as the wind goes calm, then light southerly.

Friday it will be up to 72°, sunny and windy with the south wind gusting to 25 mph. That nice day is the last of it for a few days as a wet cold front shows itself overnight with a 60% chance of rain.

Pow! The cold front hits with Saturday morning beginning about 41° and wet. The rain will stop but not the cold as the wind will be out of the north at 20-25 mph and gusting to 35. Saturday's high will be in the low to mid-40s and...

Saturday night could bring temperatures in the low 20s. The hard freeze will cause problems to unwrapped pipes. The north wind is expected to be bitter cold, blowing 20-25 mph and gusting to 35.

Sunday will be cold again with a high of 38° in the afternoon and down to 26° overnight.

The cold front will begin to go away on MLK Day Monday.

City Council agrees to Local Option Election and Spending Matters

The Lampasas City Council convened Monday evening in the first Council meeting for 2019, with a full Workshop and Regular session. The Workshop session was largely taken up with a review of the 2018 City Council Planning Session held on December 20th at the Hostess House. In that session Council took a tour of City Water/Wastewater facilities, learned about water sourcing and the relationships and issues with Central Texas Water and Kempner Water Supply; and they discussed issues they would likely be dealing with in 2019 such as; changing demographics, City personnel development and training, and considered possible rebranding and updating of City images and logos.

In Regular Session Council took the following actions:

Approved an award of quote to Southern Star Communications, Inc in the amount of **\$3,877.29** to extend existing phone lines at the Municipal Court throughout the Roy L. Thomas Building to provide service to the entire building;

approved the expenditure of **\$9,870.00** to Miller Service Company for the installation of an HVAC system at the Spring Street Pump Station;

approved the expenditure of **\$8,002.00** to Smith Pump Company for

work performed at the Spring Street Pump Station;

approved the contract for election services between Lampasas County and the City for the May 4, 2019 General election;

approved a Joint Election Agreement between LISD and the City for the May 4th general election;

approved the purchase of materials from John M. Warren Inc. to upgrade school zone signage from in the amount of **\$6,944.93**;

approved a request from the Fire Department for funds, not to exceed **\$17,000.00**, for an unforeseen repair cost of the motor for Engine One;

acknowledged and accepted the Certificate of the City Secretary certifying the review and findings of the Petition for a Local Option Election for the Legal Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages including mixed beverages to be sufficient to cause a Local Option Election; and awarded the quote from Clark Roofing & Construction for the roof replacement of 500 E. 8th and 901 S. Liveoak Buildings (Senior Citizens Community Center and Head Start Daycare) in the amount of **\$22,118.77**.

County Commissioners Met

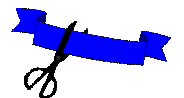
The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met on Monday morning in their first regular meeting of the year. With a very light agenda, it took only about twenty minutes for the Court to wrap up its business. There were no funding requests discussed or approved by the Court. The only action involving any type of funding measure was the routine approval of the purchase of bonds for County officials whose positions require that they be bonded. The total purchase cost of the bonds was not included in the stated request.

Other actions of the Court were the approval of the surplus sale of two pickup trucks, and the approval of the Accounts Payable report.

In the Public Comments portion of the session, Commissioner Carroll brought up that the County Ambulance Service contract will need to be reviewed, as it expires in September. Other commissioners agreed there were several areas in the contract they would like to reexamine. Judge Hoyer noted that for there to be any public discussion of the contract, it would need to be entered as an agenda item and suggested putting it on the agenda for the Court meeting of February 11th.

Also, in Public Comments, Mr. James Alexander addressed the Court regarding a water crossing on County Road 2109 where the road crosses Sims Creek. It is an old crossing and recent heavy rains have accelerated the deterioration. He also wanted it noted that Google Maps incorrectly labels the road as County Road 39 and has caused confusion in locating addresses. Frequently there is traffic, even gravel and delivery trucks driving up to his gate, with the drivers believing they should follow the route on through.
