The Weather

Today: Patchy fog before 9am. Otherwise, mostly cloudy, with a high near 63° and S-SW wind 5-15 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy, with a low of 49° and south wind of 5-10 mph becoming W-SW after midnight.

Thursday: Sunny, with a high near 68° and west wind 5-10 mph becoming light and variable in the afternoon.

Overnight it will be cloudy with a low around 52° as the wind goes calm, then light southerly.

Rest of the week: Friday it will be up to 72° but cloudy, and in the afternoon there is a small chance of rain, along with a good deal of wind. Overnight, the rain chances go up to 60%, the wind shifts to the W-NW and it gets very windy and down to 40°.

Saturday morning greets us with a cold front that will only allow up to about 46° for the high and the north wind will be stiff, 15-25 mph and gusting to perhaps 40 mph.
