

## The Weather



**The High yesterday 79° The Low this morning 55°**

Look for cooler temperatures today as a cold front, the clouds and storms cap the temperatures. Forecasters are saying that many locations will see their high temperatures early today and will become cooler in the afternoon and evening. The rain should let up for a while this evening and tonight before the next front arrives, but during this time, we may see a surge of moisture bringing another round of rain/storms. Friday looks to stay cloudy with increasing rain chances throughout the day. A front will come through, then return as a warm front by afternoon. Saturday should be clear with strong N winds and a high in the upper 50's.

**Today:** Cloudy with a high near 53°, and a 70% chance of showers with a possible storm this afternoon. The wind will be N-NE at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Cloudy with a low around 51° and N wind at 5-10 mph. There is a 60% chance of showers through the night.

**Friday:** Stormy with a high near 63° and an 80% chance of showers and storms. Winds will be NE at 5-10 mph shifting to the S in the afternoon.

**Friday Night:** Winds will be S at 5-10 mph shifting SW in the night. Skies will be cloudy with a low of 51°. There will be an 80% chance of showers and storms late Friday evening.

**Saturday:** Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 62° and W wind at 5-15 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph.

**Saturday Night:** 33° with mostly clear skies, and N-NE wind at 10-15 mph.

## Jail Contractor Walks off Job

The Lampasas County Commissioners held a called meeting yesterday at 9am. Commissioners went into executive session with the subject appearing to be a problem with Krueger Construction of Victoria, General Contractor on the Lampasas



County Jail project. There was no mention made prior to the meeting on the exact problem.



After the meeting, it was announced that Krueger had defaulted on the project. And that the completion of the Jail would be delayed. A prepared release from Judge Randy Hoyer's Office said "the interest of the Lampasas County Taxpayers are protected by statutory payment and performance bonds with a highly rated insurance company-Travelers Insurance."

When asked what the evidence of the default was, Judge Hoyer said that over the weekend the contractor and all of his workers had simply packed up everything and left the site. Krueger, as of Wednesday afternoon has still not contacted the County. We have learned that at least some of the sub-contractors have not been paid. It is also noted that the original completion date on the contract was for October 2019 and because of bad weather days, etc. that had been moved up to December or as late as early January. We were told that they were now in default of the contract end date.

Lampasas Radio attempted to contact Krueger Construction for comment but they company's phones would not pick up and their mailbox was full.

According to Judge Hoyer, the Jail is about 90% complete.

## Accident on US 281N

Lampasas Radio received the following Press Release from Sergeant Bryan Washko of the Texas Department of Public Safety: "Texas Department of Safety Troopers responded to a major crash January 15th approximately 4 miles south of the City of Adamsville. At approximately 5:37 AM, an 18-wheeler loaded with steel beams was traveling northbound on US 281. Weather conditions were foggy and the roadway was wet. The driver of an 18-wheeler was travelling at an unsafe speed and lost control of his truck rolling onto its passenger side losing his load. A second 18-wheeler was traveling southbound on US 281 approaching the crash scene. The driver of second 18-wheeler stated he observed the truck roll onto its side.



The second 18-wheeler struck the steel beams which caused damage to the tires of his truck and trailer. A third 18-wheeler was traveling northbound on US 281 approaching the crash scene. The driver of the third 18-wheeler was unable to avoid driving over the steel beams in the roadway. The third 18-wheeler took evasive action after colliding with the steel beams and veered off of the roadway and struck multiple trees. The third truck came to rest in at the bottom of Patterson Creek. Traffic was diverted throughout the day for several hours as clean-up crews worked the scene."

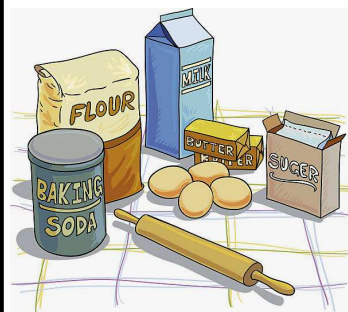
