

## The Weather

High yesterday was 63° The low this morning was 50°

**Today:** Sunny, with a high near 69° and NW wind 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Patchy fog after 3am, otherwise partly cloudy and a low around 49° with calm to 5 mph south wind.

**Friday:** A 20% chance of rain and patchy fog before noon, then partly sunny with a high in the low 70s. The S-SW wind will be 5-10 mph, increasing later afternoon.

Overnight, a 30% chance of rain and the S-SW wind of 10-20 will shift to NW and become gusty to 30 mph. The arrival of the cold front that was earlier thought to bring temperatures into the mid-20s is now thought to be no nearly so severe. Friday night it will likely get down to just below 40°.

**Rest of the week:** Sunshine on Saturday and up to 48° in spite of the cold front. Windy, with a N-NW wind 15-25 mph with gusts to 35. Saturday overnight, the cold front will likely bring a light freeze or frost at about 29°.

Sunday should bring an afternoon high about 50°, with N-NW wind around 5 mph in the afternoon. It will get down into the low to mid 30s overnight.

MLK Day on Monday should be warmer, up to 59°, with south wind 10-15 at first but increasing to 30 mph in gusts.

## Kempner Teen in Juvenile Facility Over Gun Threat

School safety and gun control is again at the forefront in the minds of both local officials and state leaders.

A release from Lampasas Sheriff's Office into our studio advises that a juvenile called them and reported that a classmate had sent threatening messages and images possibly involving the threat of a firearm at school.

Deputies immediately went to a Kempner residence and made contact with a 13 yr old white male, and with his father. The juvenile was detained and turned over to juvenile authorities and is now in the Bell County Juvenile Detention Center, charged with Exhibition or Threat of Exhibition of Firearms, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Perhaps the incident is simply foolish loose talk by a 13 yr old, but authorities believe they must act on even the slightest hint of gun violence in our schools.

The Texas Legislature is now planning for upcoming debates on the same issue. Governor Abbot favors the arming of school district staffs, Democrats in the legislature push back on increasing the number of guns in schools. Both sides of the house seem to agree that mental health resources in schools should be broadened to hire behavior counselors and one house member suggests mental health should become part of school curriculums.

Some bills filed in the legislature would harden schools to install metal detectors or screening wands, reduce the number of entrances and exits. Gun control advocates say they want to add more gun control laws.

The difficult problem before us begs the question, what do you, dear readers, think would work best?
