## The Weather

High yesterday was 69° The low this morning was 46°



**Today:** Patchy fog early morning, then partly sunny with a high near 74° and S-SE winds shifting to SW at 10-15 mph and gusting in the afternoon.

**Tonight – the cold front arrives:** A 20% chance of showers and partly cloudy with a low around 39°. Add in a very windy evening with S-SW wind 15-20 mph that will shift to NW at 20 to 25 mph after midnight as the cold front hits. The noisy wind could gust to 35 mph.

**Saturday:** Sunshine will appear, but it will likely be cold with a steady temperature about 44°, and with NW wind 10-15 mph and gusting to 20.

Saturday overnight will be clear and the temperature should drop fast, down to about 30° early morning. The good thing is that the cold front will be passing on through with the wind dropping to 5-10 mph by sunup.

**Rest of the weekend:** Sunday will be mostly sunny and up to 54° with NW wind 5-10 mph and shifting to E-SE in the morning. Overnight it will drop down to about 38°.

**MLK Day Monday** should get up to 63° with south wind 10-20 mph and gusting a bit. It is the tail end of the cold front but... It looks like another short-lived cold front could be right behind it, coming in on Tuesday.
