Today: Becoming cloudy with a high near 58° and light SE wind becoming S-SE at 10-15 mph.

Tonight: With a 90% chance of rain, look for the showers to begin around 9pm with a low temperature near 41° tonight. The wind will be SE at 10-15 mph.

Wednesday: An 80% chance of rain with a high near 54°. Wind will be S-SE near 10 mph.

Wednesday Night: Mostly cloudy and a 40% chance of showers before midnight. The low will be near 45° and the wind will be light shifting to the W after midnight.



Twice is Not as Nice in the Flu Season

Up to 18 million people have gotten the flu this year according to the CDC's latest estimates. Up to 210,000 people have been hospitalized and thousands have died, including 39 children. They're B strains of the flu dominating, something that hasn't happened in the U.S. in nearly 30 years. With a second wave coming, flu experts say it's not too late to get vaccinated before things pick up again.


