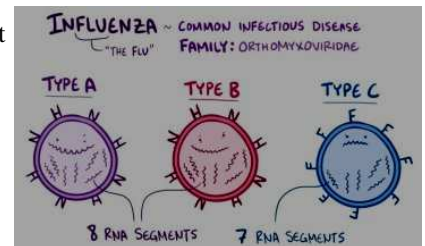

Up to 210,000 people have been hospitalized and thousands have died, including 39 children. They're B strains of the flu dominating, something that hasn't happened in the U.S. in nearly 30 years. With a second wave coming, flu experts say it's not too late to get vaccinated before things pick up again.
