The Weather

The high yesterday 48° This morning's low 46°

Today: Cloudy with a high near 63°. Look for W winds today near 5-10 mph and a 50% chance of showers this afternoon. A weather system is making its way east over the next day and is expected to bring additional rain to our area.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy skies will see the overnight low around 51°. The 50% chance of rain continues with patchy fog possible. Winds will become calm.

Friday: Partly sunny with patchy drizzle in the morning and a high near 66°. Wind will be light from the west. A cold front is expected to pass through on Friday on the heels of a Thursday night system providing slightly cooler temperatures.

Overnight Friday: Mostly cloudy with light N-NE winds and a low temperature near 49°.

Saturday: Mostly cloudy with a 20% chance of showers in the afternoon and a high temperature near 61°, and E-NE winds at 5-10 mph becoming S-SE.

Saturday Night: A low near 56° and mostly cloudy skies. Winds will be S near 10 mph.

This morning, Lady Badger Basketball Coach, Mark Myers visited with Ken Gontarek about the 2nd round of upcoming district play. The Lady Badgers travel to Gatesville tomorrow.

Coach Myers spoke about how the Class 4A Region1 District 6 that the Badgers are in is the toughest 4A District in the state. The players shared this morning that this district is much more physical than what they are used to, as Coach Myers said, they play with more finesse. The consensus is that while the Badgers are excellent, they were a little unprepared for the physical side of the game in their new district. Although the players and the coach felt that having played these teams before, they have an advantage.

The next games are big, and if the ladies win two, they will make the play-offs. Tomorrow the ladies head to Gatesville, a very good team with 5 senior starters, including one that is over 6 feet tall. Coach Myers said to look for Addison McDonald to play point guard tomorrow, and the ladies hope to improve on rebounds, and getting the ball out.

The game will be played in the Gatesville High School gym, which Coach says is pretty big. They are not selling tickets on line, admission will be at the door and Gatesville is limiting the number of people admitted, though Coach did not know how many that would be. All 3 games are in one gym, as per Gatesville ISD protocols, and begin at 5pm. The Lady Badger Varsity is expected to tip-off at 7:30pm.

Coronavirus Update



Dr. Hay shared this morning that Lampasas County now has 1296 total cases, an increase of 29 cases reported since yesterday. The number of active cases in our county is 117, up 27 from yesterday and 7 residents of Lampasas County are in the hospital.

The State of Texas saw a whopping 25,512 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 5,017 new probable cases. 13,870 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

Vaccinations...

The DSHS website shows that as of yesterday at 12:34pm, Lampasas County has had 391 people vaccinated with one dose, and 51 residents have been vaccinated with the second dose. Also, according to the DSHS website, as of 12:34pm yesterday, Texas has been sent 2,456,550 total doses of the vaccine. This indicates 730,975 doses were sent to Texas since yesterday. Of the vaccines received, 1,426,859 doses have been administered. That is a total of 58% of the available vaccine. 1,241,950 Texas residents have received one dose, and 184,909 have been fully vaccinated.

More Vaccine Notes:

In the interest of figuring out how the vaccine is distributed, Lampasas Radio found this excerpt from Texas Tribune; "After the staff at Austin's Tarrytown Pharmacy hustled to vaccinate 500 vulnerable Texans and front-line workers over the holidays, pharmacist Rannon Ching logged into an online state system used to track the vaccines.

Then he panicked.

According to the system, his Tarrytown pharmacy hadn't vaccinated anyone. The numbers on his screen indicated all 500 doses were still sitting on his shelf.

"I freaked out thinking, 'Oh my gosh, they're not going to give me any [more] doses because they think I'm not giving anything,'" Ching said. (cont'd on back)

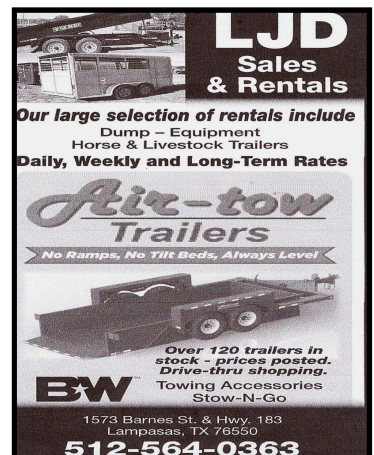

The Burn Ban has been lifted until January 25th.

The CDC website offered this: "The federal government oversees a centralized system to order, distribute, and track COVID-19 vaccines. All vaccines are ordered through CDC. Vaccination providers receive vaccines from CDC's centralized distributor or directly from a vaccine manufacturer."

The implementation of COVID-19 vaccine distribution involved detailed planning focusing on every step of the process including: 1) *Coordinating the distribution of vaccines and needed supplies from centralized locations;* 2) *Developing processes for ordering additional doses of the vaccine after the first supply has been shipped;* 3) *Deciding who should receive a vaccine first, based on national recommendations, if there are not enough doses of the vaccine for everyone;* 4) *Reporting on vaccine inventory, administration, and safety using a variety of new and enhanced data systems;* 5) *Developing plans to assess vaccine effectiveness, which means how well the vaccines protect against COVID-19 under real-life conditions;* 6) *Making sure the public, healthcare providers, state and local health departments and others receive timely, credible, clear communication about all aspects of the vaccination program*
