The Weather

The High yesterday 49° The Low this morning 43°



Today: Sunny, with a high near 51° and N-NW wind 10-15 mph and gusting to 25 mph.

Tonight: Clear sky and a low around 33° and calm wind becoming S-SW around 5 mph after midnight.

Thursday: Sunny, with a high near 61° and S-SW wind 5-10 mph becoming N-NW in the afternoon.

Mostly clear overnight with a low around 32° and N-NE wind 5-10 mph.

Rest of the week: Friday it will be up to 54° with N-NE wind 5 mph becoming S-SW in the afternoon.

The weekend picture is becoming a little more doubtful as a useful day, a 50% chance of rain shows up Saturday, with a high around 55°. The wind will be southerly and light. The rain chances continue into the early evening.

Sunday will be a little better, getting up to the low to mid 60s with some west wind. That should carry over into Monday but get cooler Monday night and into Tuesday.

Commissioners Meet in Special Called Session

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met Wednesday morning in a Called Meeting, primarily for the purpose of approving Payroll (\$111,461.18) and Payroll Taxes (\$37,185.00) and Billing and Accounts Payable for January 24, 2019. Judge Randy Hoyer noted there is a House Bill up before the State Legislature that if passed will shift the required timing and allow the Court to make these approvals during their regular sessions on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, and not call extra meetings for that purpose.

During the Called meeting the Court took up some "housekeeping" matters. They approved resolutions to allow newly installed County officials with financial responsibilities to access accounts where County funds are deposited; Texpool, Multi-Bank Securities, and First Empire Securities.

Finally, the Court addressed an amended Final Plat on the Cottonwood Mesa Subdivision. In the earlier version of the Final Plat, the road going into the subdivision cut across a flood plain area. Recent heavy rains caused that section of the road to flood. The developers, Lone Start Land Partners, working with Commissioner Bobby Carroll, had the road moved over so that it would not cross the flood plain. The Court approved the amended plat.

Third Street Bridge Reopened

The bridge over E. 3rd street was reopened Tuesday afternoon according to Lampasas City Manager Finley deGraffenried.



The bridge, damaged by a pickup truck that rolled over it sometime early Sunday morning, was closed to traffic pending inspection by the state bridge inspectors.

No release has yet been issued by Lampasas Police on what, if any, charges are being filed against the driver who went over the bridge, then left the scene with his pickup lying on its side in the water below, leaking fluids and trash into the creek.

The Cen-Tex Food Pantry Opens to Furloughed Gov. Employees as Well as Vets

Central Texas Veterans Health Care System is proud to partner with Central Texas Food Bank to provide food security to those in need. The program normally provides food assistance to Veterans onsite at VA Medical Centers, but with the continued government shutdown, the decision was made to also assist furloughed government employees who were also in need of food security.

Texas Legislature Pressed by Texas Association of Broadcasters

TAB and 15 other statewide public interest groups have joined forces to advance four amendments to the state's Sunshine Laws. The amendments would:

- Restore Texans' access to final government contracts with private companies,
- Shed light once again on public funds given to non-profits to perform government functions,
- Provide access to deliberations of public business conducted in private electronic accounts (already classified as a public record) to prevent corruption, and
- Restore public access to dates of birth contained in public records to ensure proper identification of individuals.

Texas' Open Government laws once stood as a model for the nation's 49 other states. Now, Texas is the only state in the country where contractors can decide to keep their contracts secret by claiming – with little, if any, proof – that allowing their release would place them at a potential competitive disadvantage.
