## The Weather

High yesterday was 52° The low this morning was 30°



**Today:** Sunny, with a high near 61° and S-SW wind 5-10 mph becoming E-SE in the afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear, with a low around 32° and east wind 10-15 mph turning N-NE in the evening with gusts as high as 20 mph.

**Friday:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 52° and N-NE wind 5-10 mph becoming S-SW in the afternoon.

Overnight it will be partly cloudy and down to 36° at the low point just before daybreak.

**Rest of the week:** Sprinkles are possible Saturday morning, then partly sunny in the afternoon and up to 56° with light SW wind turning NE. Overnight another chance of sprinkles early evening, then mostly cloudy and down to the upper 30s.

Sunday should be sunny, with a high near 63°, and light west wind becoming SW for afternoon and evening. Monday will bring sunshine and up to 65° in the afternoon with a bit of wind.

## Friday's District Court

District Judge John Gauntt held court in Lampasas on Friday, Jan. 18<sup>th</sup> with a long list of 44 cases. It appears that 8 of those cases were finished with sentences or closure.



Patrick Howard Martin of Lampasas was charged with aggravated assault and punished with 10 yrs deferred adjudication, a \$2,000 fine and court costs. In another case, Martin was charged with intoxicated assault with a vehicle and pled to a lesser Class B DWI with a sentence of 16 days jail time with credit for time served.

Kimberly Day Delacruz of Lampasas was charged with possession of a PG1 drug and punished with 6 yrs of TDCJ with credit for time served, plus court costs.

Coleton Danclin Nichols of Lampasas was charged with having a prohibited substance in a correctional facility and was punished with 5 yrs deferred adjudication and court costs, but being held and transported to CTTC.

Lee Patrick Anthony was charged with possession of a PG1 controlled substance and punished with 10 yrs deferred adjudication probation plus court costs and being transported to CTTC.

Daniel Nolan Dunsmore of Kempner was charged with a PG1 drug possession case and was already under probation. That probation was revoked and Dunsmore is now looking at 294 days of State Jail time with credit for time served, plus court costs.

Carlos Mandujano, homeless, was charged with impersonating a public servant but is evidently going to be released when signed in for mental treatment.

Cindi Diann Odom of Lometa was charged with PG1 drug possession. Her current probation is to be continued but SAFPF was ordered. She is to remain in custody until transported.

Cases set for a return to court on Feb. 8 include Zachary Austin Kelley, charged with aggravated sexual assault of a child; Elvis Glen Smith of Milano, TX, charged with aggravated sexual assault of a

child; Zachary Michael Porter of Kempner, charged with aggravated sexual assault of a child; Israel Alvarez of Lampasas, charged with possession of a PG1 drug and evading arrest; Jordan Kyle Miller of Lampasas, charged with possession and transporting chemicals with intent to manufacture methamphetamine; Billy Ralph Bruns of Lampasas, charged with assault on a public servant and possession of a PG1 drug; Joel Travis Meadows, DWI; Steven Wayne Stem of Spring, TX, charged with possession of a PG1 drug.

Cases set for a return to court on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> include Lee Anthony Garcia of Lampasas, charged with assault on a family member/impeding breath or circulation; theft of a firearm and possession of a PG1 drug. Also in on the 15<sup>th</sup> is Ashley Nicole Loyless of Lampasas, charged with possession of a PG1 drug; Robert Luther Trevino, charged with fraud.

## Grand Jury Cases

The January Term Grand Jury met on January 16 and came back with 18 true bills that saw the cases handed over to prosecutors for further court actions.

Martin Gonzales-Cano is charged with sexual assault in a case brought in by Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. Other assault cases are brought against Shane Edward Johnson, Rex James Eicher and Patrick Howard Martin.

There were 8 drug cases with most of them for a PG1 substance, which was usually methamphetamines.

There was one case of a burglary of a building, charged against Billy Joe Kirkham III and a hit and run case filed against Thomas Stephen Riley.
