County Commissioner's To Meet on Monday


Lampasas County Commissioner's Court will be in their regular 4th Monday session on Monday at

9am. After last week's worries over the Jail Project and the contractor walking off the site, we wondered if there were some developments.

According to County Judge Randy Hoyer, the contractor, Kreuger Construction, for whatever reason, just voluntarily defaulted on the job. They evidently defaulted on a few other jobs as well. Hoyer said the County received a copy of a letter to the bonding insuror, Travelers Insurance, stating that they were defaulting.

Now, Travelers will pay off the subcontractors what they are due, and Traveler's, according to the Judge, will select a new general contractor to come in and finish up the job. Hoyer says the County is going to be in a special meeting, either next Friday or the next Monday, with the insurance company and they will find out more about the process. He says they are now hoping the project will only be delayed for 3 or 4 months.




