The Weather



High yesterday was 63° The low this morning was 37°

Today: Clouds rolled in about 3am this morning and the wind shifted to easterly and very light. It's expected that the sun will be back by midday, with a high about 52° and the E-NE wind will shift to southerly in the afternoon.

Tonight: A slight chance of sprinkles after 3am, but mostly cloudy will be the rule, with a low around 38° and SE wind 5 mph and down to calm.

Saturday: A 20% chance of rain in the morning, then mostly cloudy and up to 53°, with a north wind that will be light to calm.

Saturday overnight will be partly cloudy and down to 39° with the calm wind shifting to west and light.

Rest of the weekend: Sunday will be mostly sunny and up to 64° with west wind 5-10 mph. Overnight, it will be down to 44° and the wind will shift to S-SW.

Next week: As of now it appears that Monday will be in the 60s but windy as another cold front comes in Monday night.
