## The Weather



**The High yesterday 74° The Low this morning 41°**

Look for mild temperatures today, and increasing rain chances from west to east tomorrow as a cold front crosses the area. The northwest part of our region will see their high temperatures by noon tomorrow. Tomorrow night look for cooler temperatures and a dry air mass. Temperatures Tuesday night could be near freezing.

**Today:** After the fog burns off, sunny with a high near 72°. Light and variable winds becoming SE at 10-15 mph this afternoon.

**Tonight:** The chance for showers increasing to 60% overnight with winds S at 10-15 mph. The low will be near 51°.

**Tuesday:** The morning will have a 30% chance of showers and storms before noon, then skies will clear to mostly sunny. The high temperature will be near 65°. Winds will be S at 10-20mph shifting to the NW in the afternoon, gusting to 25 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Winds will be N-NW at 15-20 mph, with 25 mph gusts possible. Skies will be partly cloudy with a low near 36°.

**Wednesday:** Sunny skies and a high near 58°. Winds will be N-NW at 10-15 mph.

**Wednesday Night:** Mostly cloudy skies with a low near 38°. Winds will be E-NE at 5 mph

**Lampasas County Commissioner's Court** met this morning in their regular 4<sup>th</sup> Monday session at 9am.

The agenda for Monday's meeting contained items on a possible septic tank variance, request for bids on road materials, the Constable Precinct 4 matter that was tabled in the last meeting, the Hilltop Springs Ranch Estates, Drought Disaster Loans and Fleet Management leases for the Sheriff's Dept. There is the usual "Jail Project" discussion indicated at the end of the agenda

**Lampasas City Council** will hold their regular 4<sup>th</sup> Monday session on Monday evening in Council Chambers. The workshop begins at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion regarding creating a Tree Preservation Ordinance, updates from the Lampasas Riding Club relating to the 580 sports complex Riding Arena, and discussion regarding including Form Survey to new construction inspection process.



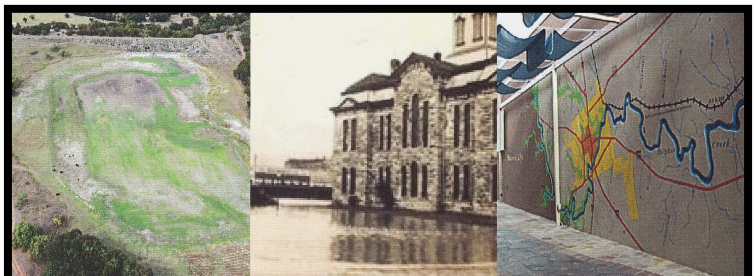

Also on the agenda is a resolution expressing support for the Annual Spring Ho Festival and nominating a candidate for election to the Board of Directors of Central Texas Water Supply Corporation.

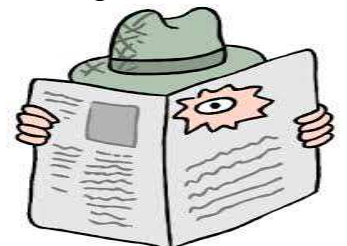

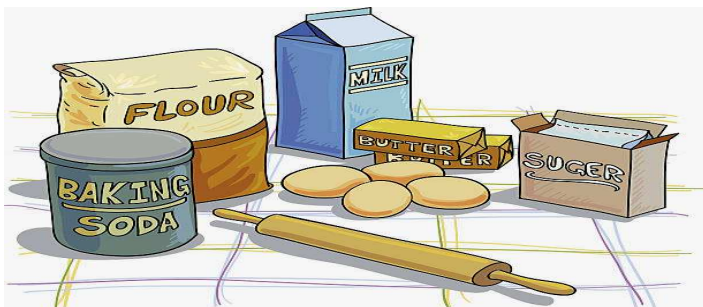

**Lampasas Radio** has learned that the local Burger King restaurant located on N. Key is tending to a few last minute equipment glitches. They hope to open very very soon!

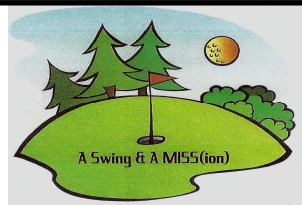
