The Weather



Yesterday's high 69° This morning's low 32°

Today: Mostly sunny with a high near 49°. There will be a cool northwest wind around 5mph becoming an east wind later in the afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low around 34°. South southeast winds around 5mph bringing in some warmer weather for Wednesday and Thursday.

Meetings on Monday



The Lampasas County Commissioners met at 9am yesterday in the downstairs courtroom at the courthouse with four commissioners present, Judge Randy Hoyer absent, and Precinct 4 Commissioner Mark Rainwater presiding. It was a light agenda. Much of the Court's attention was taken up in the Public Comment and Announcement portion of the meeting.

Victor Uvalle, Risk Management Consultant from the Texas Association of Counties (TAC), briefly addressed the Court to reintroduce their work with counties in risk control services and reducing the number of Workers Compensation insurance claims. Also, in Public Comments, Precinct 2 Commissioner Jamie Smart informed the Court that he had received a notice from White Water Midstream, an Austin based company that provides gathering, processing, and transportation services to the oil and gas industry. The notice said they are contracting land owner to seek right-of-way for construction of a 24-inch natural gas transmission line, for what they are calling the, "Bangle Project". The pipeline is expected to cross the county through Red Bluff, near Lometa, south to the Burnet County line.

Other actions taken by the Court included:

Approval of the Accounts Payable report; approved Request for bid for asphalt and emulsion, to be posted February 12th, and awarded March 12th, and appointed Commissioner Jamie Smart to serve as the permanent elected official representative on the Hill Country Community Action Association (HCCAA) Governing board. HCCAA is a private, non-profit corporation that provides services to the elderly and other persons needing assistance, through its Senior Centers.

City Council Meets



The Lampasas City Council met Monday evening in a brief Special/Executive session, a Workshop session and a Regular session.

The Workshop session was largely taken up with a discussion of the status of projects funded through the 2016 Certificate of Obligation (CO) issue.

These projects are the Old City Hall, Coleman Water Line, Nix Tank/Pump Station, and the Water/Wastewater Shop and Lab. City staff estimates there will be a 6.4% fund balance when the projects are completed, leaving **\$885,897** in unallocated funds. How these funds will be allocated will be a topic for the Council to take up in the future. Also, in the Workshop city staff presented some possible projects that Council may want to consider, including; City Parking Lot improvements, West Avenue E street improvements, Westridge Subdivision drainage, Library Landscaping, East Third Street improvements, Campbell Park restrooms, and security fencing for the Spring Street Pump Station.

In Regular session, Council took the following actions:
approved a request from the Police Department regarding 23 road closures and police escorts for 2019 special events in the city;
approved the first reading of an ordinance calling for a General Election to elect the expired terms of Mayor Misti Talbert, and Places One, Two, and Six Council members Delana Keele Touns, Robert McCauley, and T.J. Monroe, to be held on the 4th of May;
approved the first reading of an Ordinance calling for a Special Option Election for May 4th, to vote on whether or not to permit Legal Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages including Mixed Beverages in the City;
approved an emergency expenditure to address the bat population in the City Hall building with BAT Solutions in the amount of **\$12,800**. BAT Solutions estimated there were 600 to 1,000 bats excluded from the building;
appointed City Manager Finley DeGraffenried as representative to the Central Texas Water Supply Corporation Board of Directors;
directed Staff to proceed with drafting an amendment to fee schedule (\$15.00 per year per address) to allow for County residents to drop off recyclables at the City's Citizen Collection Station. Currently city residents pay \$6.00 per year;
approved a 5-year contract with Waste Connections for Sludge Haul Services with a base bid of \$425.00 per haul with a \$48.34 per ton disposal fee. In 2018 Waste Connections made 108 hauls;
and awarded a contract to ASJ Construction for the construction of a Water/Wastewater Building in the amount of **\$1,048,200.00**.
