As if we didn't have enough problems with the COVID virus and the economy and political infighting...

My cell phone is driving me nuts; how about you? It goes off every five minutes with some kind of message telling me that I won a prize from Walmart or Paypal, or that some account of mine is gonna be closed. I never even heard of that account before. And what about that one that says, "Hello, my name is Jenna and I'm a health professional..."? It's driving me nuts! I don't need any health insurance, I don't want any mail order drugs either, especially those, I'm too old to want to be enhanced, I like me the way I am. Get off my phone!!!!

I'm even getting the same stuff on my email. And hey, I've got a question! If there's no way to get this stuff off my phone and email, how come you don't see it on Twitter and Facebook? If they can keep it off their sites, why can't I keep it off mine? G-r-r and grumble!

OK, seriously, there are a lot of problems with all of this. The FTC and Better Business Bureau tell us there are a lot of reports and complaints coming in about identity theft and financial loss – all coming in from use of cell phones and computers.

They say that these calls and emails are not all innocent sales pitches, many of them are gathering our information for future scams. The BBB says 70% of the financial scams reported to them began with the phone calls or messages. They begin with the calls that are "phishing" scams to gather information. They attempt to get your identity information, then turn it over to scammers who go after everything from your social security account to your bank account.

So, the lesson is: If you don't know who is calling, hang up, or at least be sure you don't reveal your name or address and, never, ever, give anyone a social security number or a bank account or even the name of the bank you trade with and never, ever give your credit or debit card number to anyone unless you are really sure who you are talking to.

It is really surprising how easy these scams can happen. I've personally had several experiences of fraud with a credit card or bank account. I only caught them by carefully going over monthly bank statements and credit card statements.

Once I discovered somebody in New York was using my credit card (presumably just my number or a counterfeit card) to pay toll fees, rent cars, and to purchase clothes in stores. Luckily, the credit card company covered my losses. Other times I've caught charges against my bank account which I couldn't recover, and even had a hard time stopping them. The lesson again, don't give out your information to anybody you wouldn't want to lend your car to.

Good luck, and if you figure out a way to stop all these calls, tell me. Oh yeah, I hope you can find vaccine for you and yours.
