**Today:** A slight chance of sprinkles this morning, then mostly cloudy with a high near 52° and light wind becoming southerly.

comes down to who wins Friday's game. If Lampasas wins, and they beat the winless Eastside Memorial team the next week, they'll own the 2<sup>nd</sup> seed position going into the playoffs, and Burnet would get the 3<sup>rd</sup> seed, likely playing a better team.

So-o, it's an important game, made even more important because there's always been a friendly rivalry between the Bulldogs and Badgers. It's a short drive to Burnet and undoubtedly the Lady Badgers morale would be boosted by a good crowd of Lampasas fans following them in Burnet Gym.

The teams are in a dual meet today at Leander Glenn. The Boys JV team will be in a tournament at Leander Rouse on Saturday.

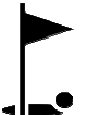
