Election Notes



The City of Lampasas is accepting applications from residents to run in the 2020 City Council Election. Places 3, 4 & 5 are seeing the terms expiring. Filing to run for Place 3 is Chuck Williamson, the incumbent. Filing to run for Place 4 is Cathy Kuehne, also an incumbent. Bob Goodart has filed to fill Place 5.

Residents have until 5pm on February 14th to apply to run in the election.

Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees will be filling places 6 & 7 during the general election. Sam Walker, incumbent has filed for Place 6 and Ryan Shahan has filed for Place 7. He is also an incumbent. Applications will be taken for these Places until February 14th at 5pm.

Trade Deal a Good Deal for Central Texas Farmers

According to Texas Farm Bureau, and the KXXV website, the ink is dry on the United States–Mexico–Canada Agreement. Supporters say could boost the Central Texas economy and grow the GDP.

"There are commodities and livestock grown in CTX that will definitely benefit from this agreement. New opportunities in Canada for dairy, for poultry, for eggs, and even new wheat opportunities in Canada because of this agreement," said Gary Joiner, the Texas Farm Bureau Spokesperson.

Senator Ted Cruz says that the deal means 2.2 million Texas jobs. "As a fierce competitor on the international stage, no state in the union has more invested in trade with our neighbors than Texas," said Sen. Cruz.

Supporters say it is all about creating access across bordering markets and putting income into the pockets of farmers and ranchers.

"US farmers and ranchers sell about a third of what they grow and raise each year to foreign markets. It's about 20% of the net farm income that farmers and ranchers count on every year is through those foreign sales," said Joiner.

Fleming Cattle and Grain in Troy says they remain optimistic for new opportunities.

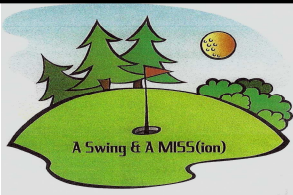

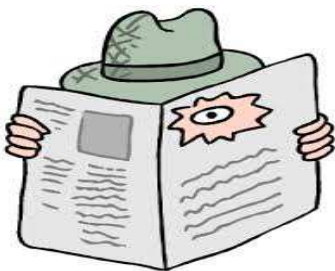

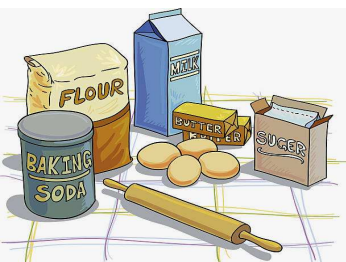

Visitation will be held on Friday, January 31 from 5pm –7pm at Blaylock Funeral Chapel in San Saba, Texas.

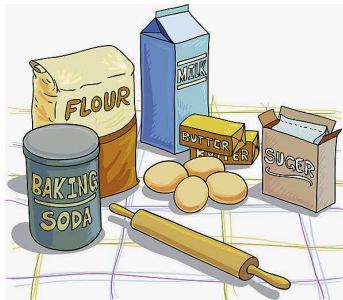
