Lady Badgers Varsity(27-5/6-2) There is some justice in life. The Lady Badgers are now ranked ahead of Liberty Hill by one prognostigator and just behind the Panthers by another.

The Texas Association of Basketball coaches shows Liberty Hill as number 22 and Lampasas at 23.

On the other hand, the Texas Girls Coaches Association had this writeup after Lampasas' victory over the Liberty Hill girls, "Jelecia Magee-Hodges scored 17 points and grabbed ten rebounds as Lampasas halted a 58 game district win streak by beating Liberty Hill 55-46. The victory was a milestone for the lady Badgers who had not beaten the Panthers this century."

And, the Association's polling put Lampasas at #14 in State 4A, while they listed Liberty Hill at a distant #24.



The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Thursday shows a reckless driver on Hwy 190E at 12:36am and the arrest of 53 yr old Nick Cortez Hernandez of Lampasas after a chase in a stolen vehicle. Hernandez had been confronted by an officer after a late night disturbance call to the 1700 block of S. Key. He jumped in a 2018 Chevy pickup and sped away at high speed. The officer, Larry Wilson, went after him and the chase finally ended when Killeen Police stopped the vehicle using tire spikes in the 4500 block of Interstate 14 (Hwy 190) at 2:46am. Hernandez was charged with evading in a motor vehicle, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and driving with an invalid license.

Other morning entries include a suspicious activity report in the 100 block of W. North at 4:35am, a credit card abuse in the 1700 block of CTE at 9:42am, a criminal non-support report in the 1000 block of Mills at 9:58am and a suspicious vehicle in the 1300 block of CTE at 11:43am.

The afternoon brought a burglary of a building report in the 500 block of E. 3rd at 2:11pm, a harassment report in the 800 block of N. Ridge at 3:04pm. Out in the country, there was a report of an assault by threat, a disturbance, and over in neighboring Copperas Cove they had to check out a suspicious person report.

Copperas Cove Police report catching two young Belton males, almost in the act of burglary. Police were dispatched to a reported vehicle burglary at about 4am Wednesday morning. On arrival to the area they discovered several vehicles had been burglarized, and when canvassing the area, they located and apprehended the two young males. They were charged with attempted burglary of a habitation, evading arrest, fraudulent IDs, and 21 counts of vehicle burglary.
