Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Friday shows a quiet start to the day and then a Criminal Mischief reported in the 100 block of E. Ohnmeiss Dr. at 10:02am. At 11:35 there was a suspicious vehicle and an assault reported in the 900 block of S. Broad St. At 11:40 a fraud report came in from Samac Lane, and another fraud report at 2:53 from Teton Ave. At 2:55 there was a theft reported in the 1700 block of CTE. A report of a Protective Order Violation in the 300 block of E. 4th St at 3:55.

In the evening there was as harassment reorted in the 700 block of Old Georgetown Rd. at 6:41, a suspicious person in the 300 block of N. Hackberry St. at 6:59pm, and a suspicious vehicle in the 600 block of E. AVE F at 10:40.

The Sheriff's Dept. Blotter shows Lometa with an accident shortly after noon. Kempner had reported threats, a traffic stop and handled a civil matter. Deputies went into Cove on a suicidal call and a reported reckless driver. Out in the county there was a warrant service, a code enforcement and a welfare check.

The Burnet County Sheriff's Office Has released the following statement:

"Murder Suspect Apprehended in Burnet County in Multi-Agency Effort"

"On 2/1/2019, the Bartlett Police Department received a report of a deceased person that resulted in a homicide investigation by the Williamson County Sheriff's Office. Through the investigation, a 32 year old suspect from Bartlett was identified.

At approximately 10:20 PM, Burnet County Sheriff's Office was notified by Williamson County Sheriff's Office that the suspect's location had been tracked to approximately the 7400 block of East FM 243 in Burnet County. The suspect was believed to be armed. Burnet County deputies, along with Williamson County SWAT, and a Department of Public Safety helicopter responded to the area. The suspect's vehicle was located in a field by the DPS helicopter and a perimeter established.

A DPS Aviation Unit drone was used to observe the suspect while a tactical unit was assembled to apprehend him. Williamson County SWAT were advancing on the suspect's location when he surrendered. He was taken into custody by Williamson County Sheriff's Office and transported from the scene.

Agencies participating in this effort include Williamson County Sheriff's Office, Burnet County Sheriff's Office, Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Parks and Wildlife, Burnet Police Department, and Burnet Fire Department."
