The Weather



The high yesterday 65° This morning's low 49°

Today: Cloudy skies and a high temperature that will top out near 52°. There is a 70% chance of rain this afternoon. N-NE wind will increase this afternoon to 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy skies and a low near 20°. Rain before 3am, then freezing rain and sleet. There is a 100% chance of precipitation. Winds will be N near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Thursday: Look for cloudy skies and the temperature falling to near 22° by noon. Look for freezing rain and sleet before noon, then a chance of snow and sleet between noon and 3pm, then a chance of freezing rain and sleet after 3pm. The sleet could be heavy at times. There is a 90% chance of precipitation, the wind chill could be as low as 7°. The winds will be N-NW at 15-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly cloudy skies with a low near 16° and wind chill values between 4° and 9°. Wind will be N-NW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph

Friday: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 33°. Winds will be N-NW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly clear skies and a low near 14°. Winds will be N-NW at 5-10 mph.

The Freezing Weather

The National Weather Service has issued a winter storm warning for Lampasas county from 6pm today until 6pm tomorrow. The overview is something like this, it it supposed to begin raining today and continue raining into early tomorrow morning. Somewhere around 3am it is expected to become freezing rain possibly mixed with sleet. The freezing rain and sleet is expected to let up around noon tomorrow, and switch over to snow and

sleet, then more freezing rain mixed with sleet after 3pm. The precipitation is expected to move out of the area Thursday evening.

Along with the winter precipitation, the arctic air will bring frigid temperatures to the area starting on Thursday morning and going through Friday afternoon, then very cold again on Saturday morning. Travel impacts are possible starting Wednesday overnight and may extend into Friday.

The low temperature Thursday night is forecast to be down to 16° , and the wind chill down to 4° . These are forecasts and are subject to change.

Lampasas ISD has not made any decisions about delaying or closing school on Thursday or Friday. Lampasas radio was told the decision would be made tomorrow morning. We have also reached out to the county to see if the county will be doing any road prep for the icy weather. We will keep you updated.

From the National Weather Service; "..WINTER STORM WARNING REMAIN IN EFFECT FROM 6PM THIS EVENING TO 6PM THURSDAY...

WHAT...A transition from rain to freezing rain, sleet and snow. Total ice accumulations of two tenths to half an inch. Sleet and snow accumulations between 1 and 3 inches.

WHERE: Portions of north central and northeast Texas

WHEN: from 6pm this evening until 6pm Thursday

IMPACTS: Travel will be dangerous. Hazardous travel conditions will impact the tail end of the Wednesday evening commute and the Thursday morning and evening commute. Wind chills as low as 5 below zero could result in hypothermia if precautions are not taken. Power outages and tree damage will be possible due to ice.



The Burn Ban is in Effect!

Governor Abbott stated that the state is working around the clock to prepare for this weather. "Every state agency is in close communication and coordination to provide resources and valuable information to keep Texans safe during these winter weather conditions. Texans are urged to avoid driving on roads and closely monitor weather conditions and guidance from local and state officials.

The Governor addressed power generation capacity ahead of the incoming winter weather and discussed the additional generation the state has brought online to strengthen the resiliency of the electric grid. ERCOT forecasts that the electric grid will be reliable and there will be enough power supply to meet demand.

The Governor urged Texans to stay off the roads if possible, and noted that the Texas Department of Transportation began pre-treating roads this past Sunday and will continue to treat roads in the coming days. He also warned Texans against the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning, and stressed that Texans should not bring generators inside their homes.
