The Weather



The High yesterday 68° The Low this morning 63°

Bundle up..... The forecasters say the cold front was moving through the Abilene area around 8am and will continue moving east-southeast. We are told there is a 15-20 degree temperature change in the air just ahead of and a few miles behind the front. Look for falling temperatures today and a blustery north wind. The forecasters share, however that they are not sure how far east the dividing line will be or how far east sleet will develop, followed by snow. An area of elevated precipitation may develop across west Texas, possibly moving into the area west of US281. Recent information indicates another system moving through south central Texas Wednesday night possibly bringing a chance of rain and snow to central Texas. At this time with the uncertainties, everything is being monitored and Lampasas Radio will keep you updated.

Today: Partly sunny with temperatures falling to the low 50's for the remainder of the day. Winds are S-SW at 10-15 mph shifting to the N in the afternoon with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy skies with a low temperature near 35° tonight. There is an 80% chance of precipitation after midnight, rain and possibly sleet or snow. The wind will be N-NE at 15-20 mph gusting to 25mph.

Wednesday: Mostly cloudy skies with a 40% chance of rain before noon and a high near 40°. Wind will be N-NW at 15-20 mph gusting to near 25 mph.

Wednesday Night: Partly cloudy with a low near 28°. The wind will be NW at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph. There is a 20% chance of rain and snow before midnight.

Thursday: Sunny with a high near 57°. Wind will be W at 5-10 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear with W wind at 5-10 and a low near 37°.

Wintry Weather Preparations



Lampasas Radio received the following from TxDOT:
BROWNWOOD – The Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Brownwood District has begun winter weather preparations throughout the nine-county district as a cold front moves into West Central Texas, bringing freezing temperatures,

wind chills in the teens and possible precipitation Tuesday and Wednesday.

TxDOT crews are pre treating roadways, bridges and overpasses on Interstate 20 (I-20), and all US and state highways throughout the district to prepare for this possible winter weather. The Brownwood District includes the counties of Brown, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Lampasas, McCulloch, Mills, San Saba and Stephens Counties. Motorists are urged to be on the lookout for slower-moving TxDOT vehicles involved in the pretreatment process, which began Monday morning.

The National Weather Service (NWS) issued a winter storm watch on Monday which includes Eastland and Stephens Counties. Across most of the Brownwood District, winter precipitation and very cold wind chills are expected Tuesday night through Wednesday. According to the NWS, a mix of rain, snow and sleet is initially expected to develop Tuesday evening north of a San Angelo to Coleman line, with mainly rain to the south. A changeover to snow is expected overnight through Wednesday morning across the area north of a line from Ozona to Brownwood, with a mix of snow, freezing rain and sleet south of that line. Any snow and sleet accumulations will make for hazardous road conditions for motorists.

Travelers are encouraged to plan ahead and check roadway conditions prior to travel Tuesday and Wednesday.

TxDOT reminds motorists to follow these helpful tips when traveling in winter weather:

- Give yourself time to reach your destination and account for possible travel delays. Have patience and share the road with other drivers.
- Drive with caution, reduce speed and increase travel distance between your vehicle and others on the road (at least three times the normal following distance).
- Do not use cruise control.
- If you start to lose control, ease off the gas pedals or brakes. Steer into the direction of a skid until you can regain traction, and then straighten your vehicle.

And if you don't have to travel, stay home.

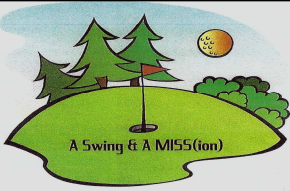

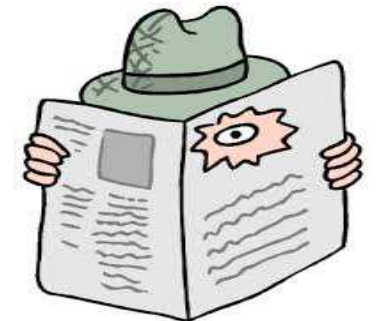
