The Weather

The high yesterday 74° This morning's low 59°
Today: Mostly sunny skies and a high near 80°. Winds will be SW at 15-20 mph shifting N in the afternoon courtesy of a strong cold front, and the wind could gust to 30mph. The front is expected to pass through the region clearing the our SE counties early this afternoon. Parts of Central Texas may have record high temperatures today as compressional warming sends temps into the low 80's before the front arrives. Expect falling temperatures and gusty winds with the front.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds with an overnight low around 42°. Winds will be N at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Friday: Cloudy in the morning with gradual clearing, and a high near 62°. Wind will be E-NE at 5-10 mph.

Overnight Friday: Mostly clear with light E-SE winds and a low near 36°.

Saturday: Sunny with a high temperature near 66°. Wind will be light from the S-SE at 5-10 mph becoming N in the afternoon.

Saturday Night: A low near 37° and mostly clear skies. Winds will be NE at 5-10 mph shifting S in the night.

Next Week: Active weather continues and arctic air is expected to arrive.



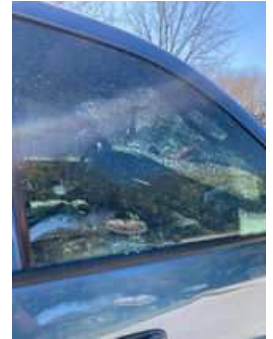
Vandals Hit East Side Lampasas

So far, according to the Lampasas Police Department, there are 14 addresses that were hit Tuesday night with vandals using something similar to an air rifle to shoot out the safety glass in car windows. The calls were reported as follows, all for criminal mischief for shooting out car windows. (This is not necessarily the order they were vandalized in). 800 block Old Georgetown Rd 7:24am, 900 block S. Chestnut 7:31am, 900 block S. Main 7:48am, 1100 block S. Key 7:48am, 1200 block E. Ave F 7:52am, 500 block Old Georgetown Rd. 8:29am, 500 block S. Pecan 9:05am, 800 block E. 3rd St. 9:24am, 1000 block Fm 580E 12:01pm, 600 block S. Pecan St. 12:12pm, Sue Ann Dr. 12:23pm, 1200 block E. Ave G 1:17pm, 1200 block E. Ave F 1:57pm, and 1600 S. Main at 9:38pm.

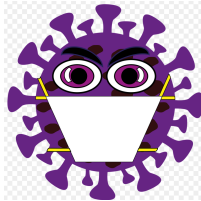

Coronavirus Update

Lampasas Radio heard from Dr. Hay that Lampasas County saw its 20th fatality from Covid-19. A woman in her 80's passed away due to Covid. Lampasas County has 1566 total cases, 148 active (an increase of 19 since yesterday) and 9 Lampasans in the hospital. The State of Texas saw 13,181 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 3,762 new probable cases. 10,827 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.



Vaccinations...

The DSHS website shows that as of yesterday at 12:08pm, Lampasas County has had 787 people vaccinated with one dose, and 148 residents have been vaccinated with the second dose. Also, according to the DSHS website, as of 12:08pm yesterday, Texas has been sent 3,719,650 total doses of the vaccine. This indicates that 5000 doses were sent to Texas since the day before. Of the vaccines received, 2,602,789 doses have been administered. That is a total of 69.9% of the available vaccine. 2,041,378 Texas residents have received one dose, and 561,411 have been fully vaccinated.
