Today: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 60°. Winds will be E near 10 mph.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds overnight with a low near 39° and a SE wind near 5-10 mph.

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay shared this morning that Lampasas County now has 1586 total cases, an increase of 37 cases reported since Wednesday. The number of active cases in our county is 142, 6 more cases than Wednesday, and 8 residents of Lampasas County are in the hospital.

The State of Texas saw 11,999 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 2,749 new probable cases. 10,523 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

Sales Tax Revenue Totals

3.1B in January

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar on Monday said state sales tax revenue totaled \$3.07 billion in January, 0.3 percent less than in January 2020.

The majority of January sales tax revenue is based on sales made in December and remitted to the agency in January.

"The slight decline in total sales tax revenue masks starkly contrasting results among economic sectors, with strong gains in collections from retail trade offset by continued deep declines in collections from recreational services and the oil- and gas-related sectors," Hegar said. "Stay-at-home spending trends that emerged in response to the COVID-19 pandemic continued through the Christmas shopping season, with elevated receipts coming from online vendors, electronics and appliance stores, building materials and home furnishings stores, big box general merchandisers and sporting goods stores."

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Thursday shows a few more calls regarding windows shot out of vehicles; in the 600 block of Old Georgetown Rd, the 700 block of Old Georgetown Rd, Snell Dr., and the 1600 block of E. Ave H. Chief Bailey told Lampasas Radio this morning that the damage was probably from the Tuesday night-early Wednesday morning timeframe, and that no one has been arrested as of this morning. The Blotter also shows a reported theft in the 1000 block of Bridge St. at 9:13am, and a reported fraud in the 400 block of S. Chestnut St. at 9:35am. The afternoon shows a report of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle in the 1000 block of W. Ave B at 12:18pm, a reported fraud in the 200 block of Riverview Dr. at 2:19pm, and a harassment in the 200 block of E. Vine St at 6:12pm.

The Sheriff's Office Blotter shows Lometa with a livestock issue. In Kempner, officers dealt with animal/livestock issues, civil matters, and a reported disturbance. Out in the county, there were reports of suspicious activity, reported thefts, medical calls, welfare checks, animal/livestock issues, reported disturbances, a mental health call, civil matters, and a stolen vehicle. Deputies went into Cove on reports of suspicious activity, animal issues, and a suicidal person.

The Jail Log Shows the arrest of 43 year old Judd Harpool of Seguin for failure to appear, and 27 year old Nathan Taylor of Kempner for intoxication assault.

"While oil and gas well drilling activity has risen from lows reached earlier in the pandemic, the December active rotary rig count for Texas was still more than 60 percent lower than a year ago, depressing sales tax receipts from mining, construction, manufacturing and equipment rental and leasing businesses. "Receipts from restaurants also remained below levels seen a year ago, while receipts from recreational services — such as live music venues, amusement parks, bowling centers and fitness clubs — remained severely depressed."

Total sales tax revenue for the three months ending in January 2020 was down 3.9 percent compared to the same period a year ago. Sales tax is the largest source of state funding for the state budget, accounting for 59 percent of all tax collections.

Historic Courthouse Burns

According to KXAN, the Mason County Courthouse has burned and is a total loss. (pictures right above)

The fire started around 10pm Thursday, and by 1:30am, only the historic courthouse's outer rock wall structure was left. The building was being prepared for renovations at the time of the fire. All county records and documents had been moved to a safe location in December 2020.

Bearden said renovations had not yet started in earnest before the fire. He said architects took paint samples and pictures inside the building, but work was not supposed to start until May. The Mason County Courthouse was built in 1909 with construction complete in 1910 at a cost of \$39,786. It was the county's third courthouse, Bearden said. He said the previous two also burned down prior to 1909. The courthouse was designed by Edward Columbus Hosford, who is noted for the courthouses and other

buildings that he designed in Florida, Georgia and Texas. The courthouse was designated a Historic Landmark in 1988 and is part of the Mason Historic District which was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974.
