The Weather

The High yesterday 36° The Low this morning 27°



Mostly clear skies tonight will create a quick cool-down after sunset. While overnight lows should be near freezing, the light southwest breeze should keep the temperatures from falling much below that. Tomorrow after the cool start, look for a quick warm up. Due to the dry airmass we should be in the 50's or 60's, and the trend should continue through the weekend.

Today: Sunny with a high near 48°. The wind will be W-NW at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low around 33° and W-SW wind at 5-10 mph.

Friday: Sunny with a high near 65°. Winds will be W at 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: Winds will be W at 5 mph shifting to the N-NE in the evening. Skies will be mostly clear with a low of 36°.

Saturday: Warming up with sunny skies and a high temperature near 67°. Winds will be N at 5-10 mph shifting to the SE after noon.

Saturday Night: 50° with partly cloudy skies, and S wind at 5-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Sunday: A high temperature near 72° with partly sunny skies and S wind at 10-15 mph gusting as high as 25 mph.

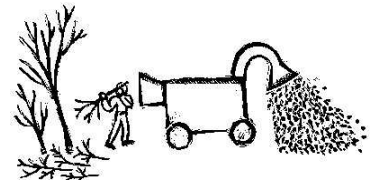

Funeral/Death Notice

A member of the greatest generation died on February 4, 2020 after achieving the age of 96. Wayne Thomas Brown, Sr. was born in 1923 to Anna Belle Carpenter and George A. Brown in Burkett, Texas in Coleman County. He enlisted in the US Navy during World War II and was sailing to Japan on the USS Kasaan Bay when the war ended. His family had moved to Fort Worth during the war and he brought his bride, Mildred Elane Grimmett (Elane Brown) here to begin their lives together. After graduating from Texas Wesleyan College at the same time as his sister and mother he started his first career as a cameraman and reporter at WBAP Channel 5. He worked with such legends as Bobbie Wygant, Pat Boone and Bob Schieffer. He covered John F. Kennedy's visit to Fort Worth and was one of the few in attendance at Lee Harvey Oswald's funeral. Retirement began at the age of 55 after 30 years at the television station which had become KXAS and is now known as NBCDFW. His second career as a rancher began after he moved to his cattle ranch in Lampasas County near Lometa, Texas. His favorite pastime was fiddling and he was a regular at the Pearl Bluegrass Show where there is a practice room named in his honor.

Mr. Brown lived the last few years of his life with his daughter, Frances Faulkenburry, and his son in law, Marvin. He is survived by them and his daughter; Mary Brown, son; Wayne Thomas Brown, Jr, his sister; Frances Thompson, Also two nieces, one nephew and numerous grand nieces and grand nephews.

He did not want a funeral but will be buried with graveside services at Center Cemetery in Lampasas County, Texas near his ranch at 1 PM on Saturday, February 8, 2020.

Badger Baseball is beginning, with the teams heading to Johnson City for a scrimmage on Saturday. JV will have first pitch at noon, varsity at 1:30pm.

Softball Fundraiser Today

The Lady Badger Softball team is holding a hit-a-thon today at 4pm.

Here's how it works:

Prior to the event: The players will use the attached form to sign up sponsors who will pledge a monetary amount per foot that the player hits the ball. Sponsors will also have the option to add a home run bonus to their pledge if they choose. Players will hand in the completed pledge form prior to the event.

Day of Event: Each player will receive 10 swings, and we will measure the furthest hit including the roll. That distance will be used to calculate the final pledge amount. The distance to the fence is 200 ft and that will be our max distance measured. Sponsors also have the option to add a HR bonus if they choose.

Example: Sponsor pledged 10 cents per foot hit with a 2 dollar per home run bonus. The player hit 3 home runs which would put their total distance at 200ft. The sponsor's total contribution would be 26 dollars to the softball program.

After the event, using their calculated distance from the hit-a-thon, players will get with their sponsors and collect the funds based on the sponsors pledge. This money will then be turned into the softball coaches by Monday, February 10th
