The Weather

High yesterday was 50° Low this morning was 31°



A weak front will make its way through our area late this morning, however forecasters are predicting afternoon temperatures in the normal range. It will be a cool night tonight, with temperatures in the mid and low 30's by morning. Sunday morning looks to be a bit warmer with highs in the 70's, but look for a cold front to come through overnight on Sunday.

Today: Sunny and a high near 62°. Wind will be W-SW at 5-10 mph shifting to the north this afternoon.

Tonight: Clear with a low near 35°. Winds will be N-NE at 5 mph.

Saturday: A sunny day with a high near 69°. E-NE wind at 5-10 mph coming around to the SE in the afternoon..

Saturday night: Winds will be S at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. Mostly cloudy skies and a low near 55°.

Sunday: Mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 74°. Winds will be S at 15-20 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers after noon.

Overnight: Mostly cloudy and a low near 45°. Winds will be from the S at 5-15 mph shifting to the N after midnight.

Monday: Mostly cloudy with a high near 56° and a 50% chance of showers and storms. Winds will be N at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Area Elections

Lometa ISD has had another resident file for the Lometa ISD School Board. All places are at large, and Courtney Duncan has filed to run for a place at large.

Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees will be filling places 6 & 7 during the general election. Sam Walker, incumbent has filed for Place 6 and Ryan Shahan has filed for Place 7. He is also an incumbent.

The City of Lometa has 2 City Council members that have their places expiring, Shad Hill and Larry Koch. Larry has filed for re-election, and Doug Brister and Ronnie Cartwright have filed for places at large. Mayor Carlos Garcia has also filed for re-election and is as of today running unopposed.

The City of Lampasas is accepting applications for Places 3, 4 & 5 as those terms are expiring. Filing to run for Place 3 is Chuck Williamson, the incumbent. Filing to run for Place 4 is Cathy Kuehne, also an incumbent. Bob Goodart has filed to fill Place 5. Residents have until 5pm on February 14th to apply to run in the election.

Dillon Best, Anthony Harris, and Jonathon Dill will advance to Regionals.

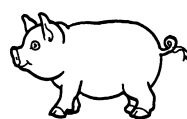
