Ag Mechanics

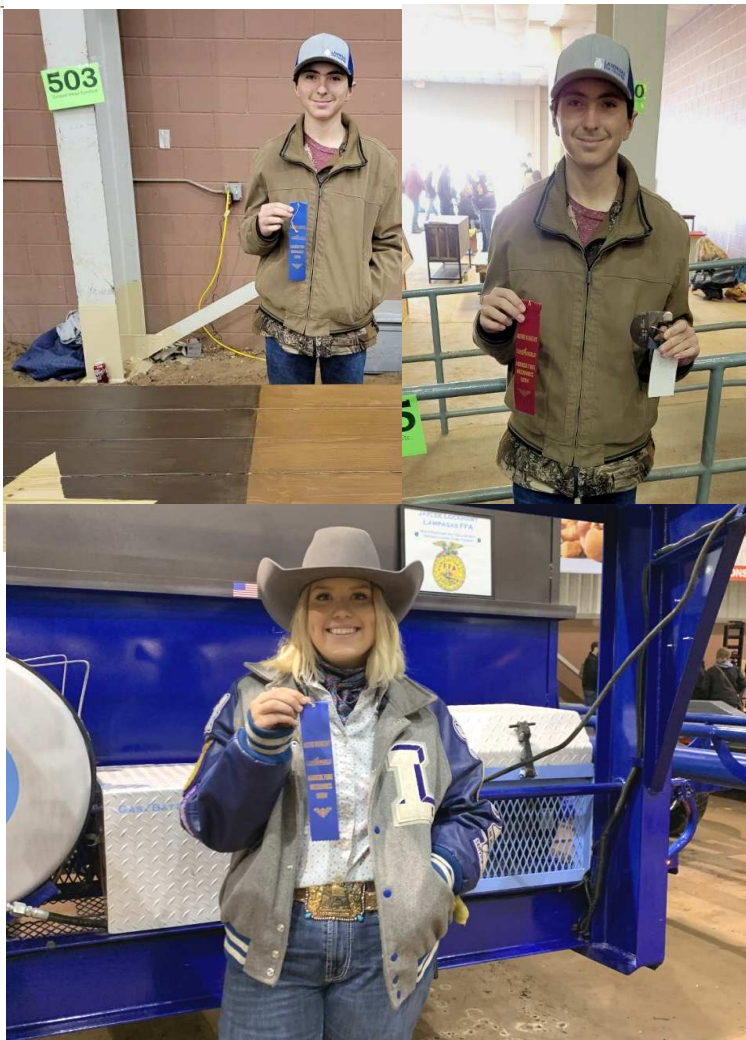

earned a blue ribbon with this project at the Fort Worth Stock Show. Jaycee plans to finish out the show season with her project at the Houston Livestock Show in March.

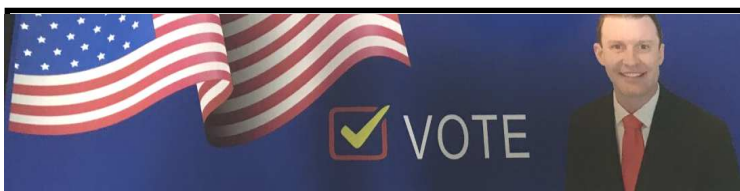

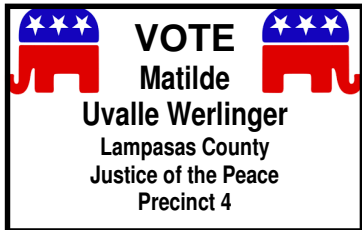

The agenda includes the consent agenda to include a budget amendment, the quarterly investment report, the purchase of playground equipment for Taylor Creek Elementary School, purchase of 1:1 Chromebook devices with emergency connectivity funds and the audit engagement for fiscal year 2021-2022. Also on the agenda is a list of bills, the calling of the School Board Election and the appointment of election judges, the 2022-2023 district calendar and a campus report from Lampasas Middle School.
