Lampasas Airport recorded 1.13 inches of rain yesterday

A Red Flag Warning has been issued for Friday February 10th.

Today: Sunny with a high temperature near 70°. Wind will be W-SW near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for increasing clouds, and the low will get down to about 39° overnight. The wind will be N-NW at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 50°. Wind will be N-NW near 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Friday Night: Look for clear skies and a low near 28°. Wind will be N-NW at 5-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with the high temperature near 55° and wind becoming E at 5-10 mph in the afternoon.

Saturday Night: Mostly clear skies and a low near 33°. Wind will be E near 5 mph shifting S-SW overnight.

Hydro-Blasting on 580W

The Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) contractor will be hydro blasting the road surface of FM 580 W in Lampasas County this week. This work began on Monday, Feb. 6, and will continue on Thursday, Feb. 9, after crews encountered a weather delay Tuesday. The hydro blasting will last approximately six days. Crews will work Thursday through Saturday and then again on Monday through Wednesday.

Hydro blasting is a cost-effective option for cleaning the road surface to create better traction for motorists.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane while work is being performed. Motorists should expect delays. Flaggers and a pilot car will guide traffic through the work zone. Please use caution, slow your speed, avoid distractions, and watch for crews when driving in this location.

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced yesterday he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.3 Billion dollars in local sales tax allocations for February. That is up 9.3% from last year. These allocations are based on sales made in December by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate increase 12.33% over the same period last year, with a \$7735.38 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a 3.35% increase over the same period last year in their rebate check of \$94,356.35

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is up 6.54% in their check of \$241,422.28. Lometa shows an increase of 2.93% from last year with a rebate check for \$10,514.97 and Kempner received a rebate for \$17,953.62, a 25.38% increase from last year.

Fabuloso Cleaner Recalled

Colgate-Palmolive has recalled about 4.9 million Fabuloso bottles due to the risk exposure to bacteria, the company announced.

The recall is for any of the cleaning product bought online at Amazon.com and other websites and at Dollar General, Family Dollar, The Home Depot, Sam's Club, Walmart, and other major retailers nationwide from December 2022 through January 2023 for between \$1 and \$11.

The products can contain Pseudomonas species bacteria, including Pseudomonas aeruginosa and Pseudomonas fluorescens, which are environmental organisms found widely in soil and water, according to the company.

"People with weakened immune systems, external medical devices, or underlying lung conditions who are exposed to the bacteria face a risk of serious infection that may require medical treatment. The bacteria can enter the body if inhaled, through the eyes, or through a break in the skin. People with healthy immune systems are usually not affected by the bacteria," said Colgate-Palmolive.

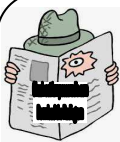

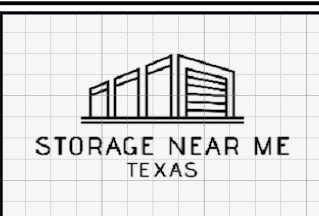
