## The Weather

**The High yesterday 69° The Low this morning 55°**



A cold front will move through the area this morning, and look for much cooler air to make its way into our area today. Look for falling temperatures today mainly in the 40's and 50's. The forecasters are telling us that a cold rain will move in from the west as early as noon, eventually covering all of Central Texas this afternoon. Then there will be a break from the rain tonight, then another round of rain should be here just in time for tomorrow mornings commute. The several days of rainfall will increase the flood threat Tuesday through Wednesday morning as another round of showers moves through. There is talk of a flash flood watch, and the locations involved depend on where the rain-making system stalls out. When that is determined, a flash flood watch may be issued.

**Today:** The chances for showers and storms steadily increases through the day. Mostly cloudy with temperatures falling throughout the day. N wind near 10 mph. A 70% chance of rain.

**Tonight:** The chance for showers at 50% after 9pm with N winds at 5-10 mph. The low will be near 40°.

**Tuesday:** A 100% chance of rain and the high temperature will be near 46°. Winds will be N-NE at 10-15 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Winds will be N at 10-15 mph, with 20 mph gusts possible There is a 90% chance of showers and storms with some places seeing heavy rainfall. The low temperature should be near 39°.

**Wednesday:** Cloudy skies and a high near 55° with a 80% chance of rain in the morning. Winds will be NW at 10 mph.

**Wednesday Night:** Mostly clear skies with a low near 35°. Winds will be NW at 5-10 mph.

## Monday Meetings

**The Lampasas County Commissioners Court** held a regular meeting this morning at 9am at the Lampasas County Courthouse. On the agenda is the consent agenda, public comments, approval of Auditor's bond, and approval of Constable's bond. The Commissioners will also be discussing a preliminary subdivision plat for Hill Top Springs Ranch, requesting bids for professional lawn care & grounds maintenance. There will also be a discussion about a contract for professional services for precinct redistricting.

The commissioners will hold a called meeting today at 1:30 pm. On the agenda is a subdivision workshop.

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet today at 5:30pm for a workshop session in City Council Chambers. ON the agenda for the workshop session is the City council work plan. Also up for discussion will be the citizen collection station recycling, promotion and hours of operation. Discussion will also include updates on the Cooper Spring Trail Grant, and the Library Park Project and use of Guthrie funds for that project, and discussion regarding outdoor burning regulated by TCEQ.



In the regular session at 6pm the City Council will hear citizen comments, the consent agenda and the city managers operational report. The New Business agenda includes submission of the 2019 LPD racial profile report, the access and use agreement between the City of Lampasas Rodeo Arena and the Lampasas Riding Club. Also included will be discussion regarding the renewal of the contract between the City of Lampasas and Waste Connections, discussion/action regarding approval of a quote to install 626 Neptune waster meters by Core & Main in an amount not to exceed \$25,666. There will also be discussion regarding approval of the special events for the city for the year 2020. Discussion/action on the use of Guthrie Funds for the Library Park Project will be discussed as well as approval of the preliminary plat of Hillside Acres.

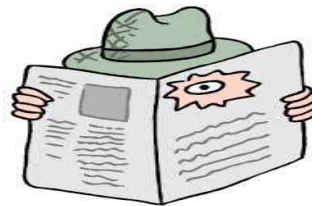

Next up for Lady Badger Softball is Friday afternoon when they host Academy for scrimmages beginning at 5pm.

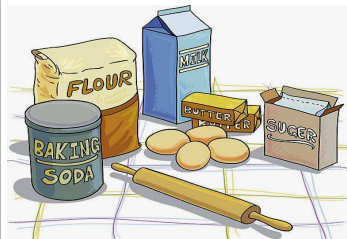
