## The Weather

## Vaccine Clinic Today

The Texas Dept. of Emergency Management is holding a Covid-19 mobile vaccine and testing clinic today. The clinic will be held at the old middle school cafeteria off Western St. behind the Boys & Girls club. This clinic is from 9am-6pm and is free of charge and no appointment is needed. Pfizer & Moderna boosters are available, but you must be 5 months from 2<sup>nd</sup> dose completion, (28 days if immunocompromised) and any students aged 12-17 will need to have a parent with them.

## Road Work in Kempner TxDOT

**shared this:** "Beginning Monday, February 14, Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) contractor Texas Materials will be constructing safety improvements at the intersection of US 190 and FM 2313 in Kempner. Improvements will include constructing a right turn lane from US 190 for motorists turning onto FM 2313 and installation of illumination at this location. Work will be mostly behind the

curb; however, motorists are asked to watch for crews, avoid distractions and to pay attention to road signs within the work zone. It is anticipated that this project will be completed in approximately 3 months, weather permitting."

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, on February 10th, there were 11,643 new and 3,955 probable cases, along with 8,943 in the hospital. There were 305 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, DSHS reports 4,627 confirmed total cases in Lampasas County.

## RPZ Inspection Due Dates

Kempner WSC sent the following to the Radiogram: "The initial RPZ policy was enacted by KWSC and ALL members were notified by mail on 2/10/2020. In that notification, we required that all necessary RPZ's be installed and tested by 4/1/2020. This is not a new policy/requirement to our membership. It has been in place for two years. For members who already have an inspection on file with KWSC, your inspection will be due one year from the date of your last inspection. For members that do not have an inspection on file with KWSC already, your initial inspection will be due on or before 4/1/2022.

Additional information can be found in the Tariff in Section G: Rates and Service Fees under #24 Cross Connection Backflow Testing on pages 38 and 39. KWSC does not endorse any particular inspector, but we have had several inspectors that have registered with us to do inspections in the area. 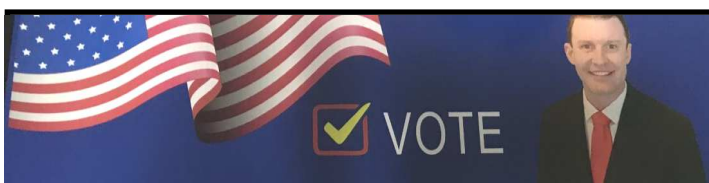

## State Primaries

March 1, the date of the state's party primaries, is barely three weeks away, and it's the election date on most voters' minds. But circle another election date: May 24. Runoff elections are invigorating for challengers and terrifying for incumbents, and some of the biggest races on this year's ballot might not be decided until then.

Two statewide Republican incumbents — Attorney General Ken Paxton and Agriculture Commissioner Sid Miller — are trying to win reelection in the face of challenges from current and former officeholders in their own party. And Railroad Commissioner Wayne Christian, a former legislator, has four opponents in his reelection bid.

A runoff between the top two finishers in a primary is required if the winner doesn't get at least 50% of the vote. (In general elections in Texas, the candidate with the most votes wins, even without getting half the votes. *(cont'd on back)*)

Former Gov. Rick Perry, for instance, won his 2006 reelection with 39% of the total votes.)

Recent polling from the University of Houston had Paxton in front of his three Republican challengers, with 39% of the vote. Land Commissioner George P. Bush had 16%, U.S. Rep. Louie Gohmert had 13% and former Texas Supreme Court Justice Eva Guzman had 8% — 24% remained undecided. If enough of that undecided group goes Paxton's way, he would avoid a runoff. Early voting starts next week, and the candidates' advertising and door-knocking from now through early and election-day voting might move those numbers. A runoff election put Ted Cruz in the U.S. Senate. He didn't beat an incumbent, but in his first election in 2012, he beat a sitting lieutenant governor, David Dewhurst, who had won four statewide elections. Two years later, state Sen. Dan Patrick, R-Houston, ended Dewhurst's reelection bid in a runoff and took over as lieutenant governor.
