Today: Sunny skies with a high near 56°. Wind will be N-NW at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will meet Monday February 13th at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, an update from Corix Utilities President (Darrin Baker) on Lampasas County Projects, appointing a Commissioners' Court Sub-Committee regarding the Hwy 281 Relief Route, removing the purchase order policy and discussion of the Stockert Subdivision Final Plat.

Lampasas City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday February 13th for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion concerning the Solar Eclipse Event 2024, the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Year End Financial Report, and the Fund 40 Project Gap Funding related to Hostess House Rehabilitation.

The Regular Session will be called to order at 6pm.

The Agenda includes presentations and proclamations, and a public hearing to accept comments regarding the Preliminary and Final Plats for the Estates of Gibson Creek Phase 1 (187.36 acres).

The Agenda also includes the consent agenda, to cover the second reading of ordinances to add Skate Park Rules and appropriate signage to the Skate Park, and the proposed 35 mph speed zone for Lampasas High School on 281.

Also included on the agenda is the City Manager's Operational Report to include information on the Skate Park, Kempner Water, the Lampasas Business Park, the sales tax report, substandard

buildings and local parks. That will be followed by Mayor's Comments, and discussion and possible action on the following: the Lampasas Police Dept. 2022 Annual Racial Profiling Report, calling the General Election for May 6th to elect the expired terms of the mayor, council Members Places One, Two and Six, providing for early voting, polling times and places and bilingual election materials, the Preliminary and Final Plats of Gibson Branch Subdivision, awarding a bid to LC Paving and Construction for the US 281 Water Line Improvements, to appoint two members of the Lampasas City Council plus the Mayor to a joint City-County Committee to study impacts and planning of a relief route connecting US 281, US 183, and US 190.

Council will then go into Executive Session on the following: Deliberation concerning the potential purchase, exchange, lease, acquisition, sale and/or value of real property.

Council will then return to regular session for action on items discussed in Executive Session.

The Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees will hold a called meeting on Tuesday February 14th at 7:30am at the Lampasas ISD Administration Building.

The agenda includes consideration of an HVAC Equipment purchase.



AAA: Every Two weeks an Emergency Responder is Killed on a Roadside

AAA says on average, two emergency responders are killed after being struck each month by a driver on a roadway who is not obeying the law. The agency calls it one of America's most lethal jobs. Those responders include tow workers.

Drivers are expected to move over to an adjacent lane to give roadside crews space to do their job safely. But, that doesn't always happen, according to Bureau of Labor Statistics data, AAA reported. Citing government data, tow operators were killed at a rate of around 43 deaths per 100,000 workers.

To address this problem, AAA is looking at Move Over laws, which all 50 U.S. states have. The agency says that awareness is the cause of the inconsistencies. Nighttime lights and flares were found to have a big impact on getting drivers to obey laws and move over to give workers a safe space.

Cliff Ruud, AAA's managing director of automotive solutions said, "AAA is using this research to promote the adoption of lifesaving countermeasures to protect tow workers and first responders. AAA is sharing these findings with other impacted industries and traffic safety advocates." Ruud said AAA will "continue educating drivers about the need to obey move-over laws because doing so saves lives."

An AAA report found that when flares and cones were added to the scene of an incident during the day or night it significantly increased the likelihood that drivers would move over a lane to give workers and the vehicle that is disabled a safe space.
