Tonight: Patchy freezing drizzle after 1am. Cloudy, with a low around 25° and N-NE wind 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Patchy freezing drizzle, cloudy and cold, with a steady temperature around 29°, N-NE wind 10-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph.




It's Friday!
