The Lampasas County Commissioner's Court will meet Monday at 9am in the Lampasas County Courthouse Commissioners Courtroom.

The agenda includes the consent agenda, the TxDOT Hazardous Safety Improvement Program Project CR 3220 and CR 3371, the Acadian quarterly report, a revision to the Lampasas County Historical Commission by-laws, an order designating a reinvestment zone for triple B Solar LLC and Affiliates, and the lawn maintenance contract renewal.

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday at 4:30pm for a workshop session the agenda will include an update on the Covid 19 Pandemic, a decision and an update regarding LEDC Business Park Roadway and Utility Improvements Phase 1 base bid and add alternate 1 and discussion and debrief relating to the Council Work Session held on February 7th.

The Regular session will begin at 6pm. The agenda includes the

consent agenda which includes discussion and possible action regarding the second reading of an ordinance calling for a General Election to elect the expired terms of Council Places 3,4 & 5. There will be board and departmental reports, as well as the City Manager's report. In new business there will be discussion of the 2021 Annual Racial Profiling Report, the Order of Election for Municipalities for the May 7th General Election, discussion regarding a Veteran's Run and Walk on Saturday November 5, 2022 at 6:30am. There will be discussion about the 3rd St. Roadway Improvement Project, discussion and possible action concerning a request from the Kiwanis club for approval of a license application to operate a Circus within the city limits, discussion and action concerning a rainwater collection system at Campbell Park and discussion and possible action regarding LEDC Business Park Roadway and utility improvements / financial participation in city infrastructure.

Early Voting

Early voting starts February 14th and goes through February 25th. Lampasas residents can vote early at the elections office at 407 S. Pecan St. #102. February 18th is the last day for counties to receive mail-in ballots.

In addition to the district-level elections, each party will choose its candidate for seven statewide seats — governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, land commissioner, agriculture commissioner, comptroller and one of three seats on the Railroad Commission.
